TERU: Channels

1. Interrogation of company officials indicated that the 120 gallons of gasoline requested in basic communication is for use in two vehicles which are located in Kyoto Prefecture and which are not required for use in connection with bakeries operating under procurement demands.

2. The Maruki Yeast Research Institute has a factory in Uji Gun, Kyoto Prefecture where these vehicles are located. However, this factory is not in operation at present and the only use to which these vehicles could be put in connection with procurement demand activities is to transport administrative personnel from Kyoto to Kobe. In view of the fact that excellent train service is available between these two points it is not felt that issue of gasoline is essential in carrying out procurement demands.

3. In view of the fact that this company is not operating on procurement demand in Kyoto Prefecture it is the opinion of this office that the subject request is merely an attempt to obtain gasoline under false pretenses.

4. In the event that gasoline is actually needed to complete procurement demands in Tokyo, Yokohama, Kobe and Kokura, where bakeries of this company are located, it is suggested that the Quartermaster receiving officers in these localities estimate the amount of Petroleum Products needed by the bakeries under their jurisdiction and forward this estimate to local Military Government Teams in compliance with Circular 154, Headquarters, 8th Army, dated 23 Sept. 1947, subject: "Estimation of Petroleum Product Requirements for Occupation Forces".
