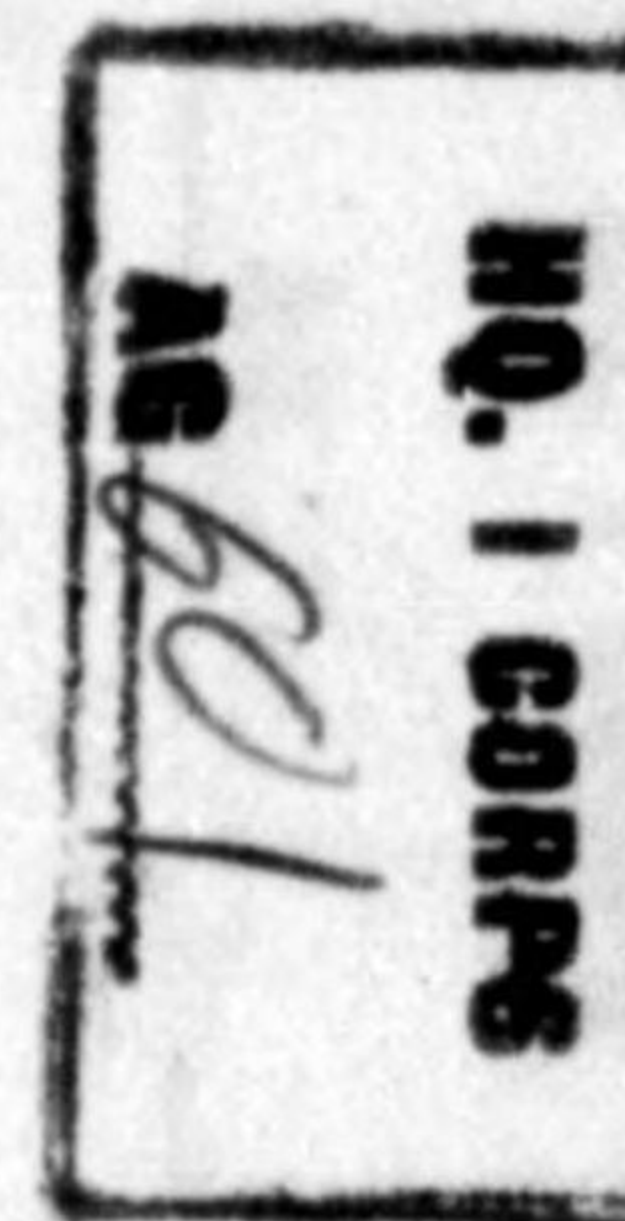

## MEMORANDUM

K.L.O. No. 46

APRIL 19 1946

To the H. Q. of the I Corps.

Subject: Solicitation for the release of the barracks of the former 541 aircraft.

1. We wish to present to the H.Q. of the I Corps the solicitation placed in our hands for our good offices by the Communication Board of the Imp. Govt. for the release of the former 541 aircraft.
2. The Communication Board of the Imp. Govt. is planning the education of 1000 freshmen for 1946 to be engaged in communication activities in the districts of Osaka and Kyoto, and for the acceptance of 500 it secured the release of the former Air Communication Corps at Kakogawa in Hyogo Prefecture, and for the other 500 it stands in need of a suitable building.
3. For the purpose mentioned in par. 2 the Communication Board wished to make solicitation to the H.Q. of the I Corps the above-mentioned barracks, and its use as the training school of communication operatives in its service.
4. The said building is  
Located at Mimakimura, Kuze Gori, Kyoto prefecture, and  
Covers an area of 2,000 tsubo, Whole area being 10,600  
tsubo, (1 tsubo is about 36 sq.f.) Styled one storey frame  
structure.
5. The said building is the remnant of the former 541 Aircraft, of which the hangar was released on Dec. 19, 1945 by the H.Q. and transferred to the Home Ministry. The buildings and the land all had formerly belonged to our office, the Communication Board, but were placed during the war time at the disposal of the army. Subsequent to the cessation of war they were occupied by the occupation troops which evacuated them about a month ago and the building have since been left without anyone to take care of.
6. The same memorandum was once presented on March 22, to the H.Q. of I Corps through the 31st Military Government Company.
7. In presenting this solicitation we should be greatly obliged if the H.Q. authorities would pay its prompt attention to this matter and give it favorable decision.

1. Inspection and survey was made of subject area. 12 June 46. This area formerly provided billets for 361st Engr. Bn. It has come to this headquarter's attention that area marked on inclosed map of Kyoto City was incorrectly marked. This error has been corrected and area, planned to be utilized, is clearly indicated.

2. Inclosed herewith is a copy of application for utilization of this area, two blueprints of area and map of Kyoto City showing location of subject area.

3. If permission is granted for release of subject area for communication and youth school, officials state that they plan to start receiving equipment and students on or about 20 June 46. These students, for communication school are expected to come from all parts of Japan and are suppose to stay in buildings marked dormitory on attached blueprint.

4. One building is planned to be used for youth school. Age of students entered in this school is between 14 and 20 years. It was erected so that youths who are too poor to go to middle school could have higher education. These schools differs in what curriculum they teach. In this school, they will teach agriculture as the main subject because it is out in the country where knowledge of agriculture is important.

5. Communication Ministry informs this headquarter that release of this area, to them, was made by telephone between them and 1st Lt. Frank Jones, 361st Engr., as stated in attached record of this telephone conversation.

b. Buildings 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8. Barracks. All buildings are in a state of disrepair, and all doors and windows have been removed. Buildings are only partially floored, and have tile roofs. Approximately 100 double-deck bunks (without mattresses) are scattered throughout the buildings.

However, the original owners were still required to continue the tax payment, and consequently wish to gain the re-use of this land as soon as possible.
