Esteemed Friend

Edward G. Hale. I reced them
with a list of checks I find that I gave a
check to W. Plant for \$310 which will
exactly ballance my ac (it has not
been presented) I sent to thee on the 5th 10^{me}
21 Haskins Butter 1 Tierce Tin Lead 3 Casks
P. Ash 1 Box Sundries \$15 B. Wax which I have
never heard whether thee has reced them
or not they were sent to Pattison & Hart of
Froy. if they have not come to hand please
write to them to send it to thee. also I
sent to thee for Trotter & Bourglaf on the 16th
62 Bbls Superfine Flour and this day 1 Bbl
Pol. Ash 1 Cask. Timothy Lead all of which thee
will please sell on my ac please write
me as soon as thee can make sale of this
Flour it will probably be in Town in 10
days from this. the weather is quite
cold and I think I will not be able
to get any Wheat off this fall for fear
of getting it frozen up. perhaps I may
send a little more flour in a few days
