THE AIMS OF THE PROJECT

- Spreading and creating Knowledge about Children and Young Literature.
- Creating a new information system about literature, by the use of Wikipedia. • Preserving and promoting local documentary heritage and collection from our library.
- Improving digital literacy and critical research among students
- Promoting Wikipedia among students, to become active editors as well as consumers.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- A single GLAM institution was allied with Wikipedia and University to promote open access and digital literacy. For the fist time a wikipedian in residence in Basque wikipedia.
- New content edition focused on basque and universal literature in Basque Wikipedia.
- Text edited by each participant may be enriched by images and audio, deeply enhancing the value of articles: 70 book covers uploaded and 25 authors' voices have been recorded.





ACTIONS

1. Digital literacy.

Some members from the Basque Wikimedians User Group (EWKE), teachers of student teams at the university: 2 trainings to new editors (6 hours).

2. Visit to Documentation Center.

Reliable references and resources avalaible to improve content edition. On average, library provides 200 references each year. Training students about information management, the reliability of online sources and critical research (3 hours).

3. Articles edition.

Students and wikipedians in residence.

4. Library sets in motion collaborative work in order to create content. Uploading quality images (photos, book covers) and audio archives to Wikimedia Commons, under free licence by OTRS code.

5. Project promotion.

Video edition (English subtitles).

Wikipedia Book at Pediapress.

Exhibitions. Content spreading by QR codes.

Publicizing the project by attending professional meeetings and using social media channels profesionaletan).

- Carry on whit this iniciative: Children & Young Literature Wikiproject.
- Currently, inspired by the results of this project, various initiatives have been set in motion: Idazlezainak (Librarians from various institutions of Donosti as wikieditors about Literature), Wikiliburutegiak (Gateway that collects GLAM iniciatives in Basque Wikipedia). Monitoring work.
