4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

(LOCAL AGENCY) On 7 February 1972, the following information was obtained from Headquarters, British Security Services Organization (BSSO), Duesseldorf (LB4577), Federal Republic of Germany (FRG), with regard to Ilse Hessel, aka: Ilse Hehsel:

Name: Hessel, Ilse  
Date of Birth: 18 November 1909  
Place of Birth: Danzig, Germany  
Citizenship: Not shown  
Occupation: Not shown  
Parents: Not shown  
Marital Status: Married to Walter Koedderman, born 21 July 1906 in Berlin, on 5 September 1940 in Berlin, Koepe-nick. Marriage ended in divorce on 29 September 1950 in Berlin. After the divorce Hessel re-verted to her maiden name.  
Residence: A check of the files, by BSSO, of the Einwohner-meldeamt -EMA- (Inhabitants Registration Office), in West-Berlin revealed that she had left West-Berlin for Canada on 15 July 1971, giving her address there as 309 Queensdale Avenue, Toronto 13.

A file check by BSSO Duesseldorf, FRG, in Berlin revealed that Ilse Hessel completed a Fragebogen preparatory to taking up work with a British Unit there in January 1958. Hessel did not take up this employment but in her Fragebogen she stated that she had come to West-Berlin on 21 October 1956 from East-Berlin and had, while being there, been a member of the Freie Deutscher Gewerkschaftsbund - FDGB (Free German Trade Union). In March 1969 she is reported to have applied for emi-gration to Canada. There is no trace in Headquarters BSSO Duesseldorf, FRG, or BSSO Berlin records with regard to Ilse Hehsel.
