IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PURCHASERS.

The following Trees, &c. were selected in Paris and its environs in the latter part of the month of January last, from several of the best and oldest Nurseries, most renowned for their skill and honesty, and the sorts named, may be implicitly relied on: they were not taken from the ground in the fall, and plunged until sold, as is usually the case in ALL nurseries, but were absolutely dug out between the 15th and 25th of January; of course their roots will be found unusually fresh and in fine order. The Pears, both Standard and Dwarf, are all on QUINCE STOCKS, and will therefore certainly produce Fruit the second, and perhaps the first year, if set out, at a favourable moment, in rich soil.

The Peaches are all on ALMOND STOCKS, which will effectually guarantee them against the Peach Worm, and the great advantage in possessing these Trees, is the fact that common Trees can be budded from the shoots they will make the latter part of the coming summer. The tops of the Peach Trees only, will PROBABLY be found in bad order, arising from the heat engendered in the bales: they should therefore be headed down, soon after they are set out; if this is attended to, 18 out of 20 will thrive well.

All the Roses are grafted.

Every Plant in the Catalogue (except the Grape Vines, of which there is but one sort), has a Leaden Mark attached to it, corresponding with the Catalogue. The few remarks made in the Catalogue about the Pears, were taken from the "Bon Gardinier," (Paris, 1840,) and Kenrich's New American Orchardist, (published in the Farmers' Library, vol. 2d, and which may be obtained at all Book Stores), and to those Works reference is made to all the fruits now offered for sale.
