





















A good picture is not sufficient, description is also required

Describe Commons media files with structured data from Wikidata

Set up your own campaign **or** participate to already set-up ones


Track and easily report participation

Tool accessible on desktop and mobile.




Browse through all opened campaigns

- Campaign creation on desktop
- Basic stats view on mobile
- Full statistics available on desktop for download



Contributions

- The tool displays a random image with key extracts of data recorded on Wikimedia Commons
- The OAuth logged-in contributor adds depicts and caption data to the picture
- Edits are automatically saved on Commons



Campaigns are entry points

- Project lead creates campaign
 - Video: bit.ly/ISACampaigns
- Campaigns defined primarily by
 - beginning/end time
 - Commons categories of images to work on
 - structured data: depict and/or captions
- Project lead invites participation


- 1,354,397 images better described
