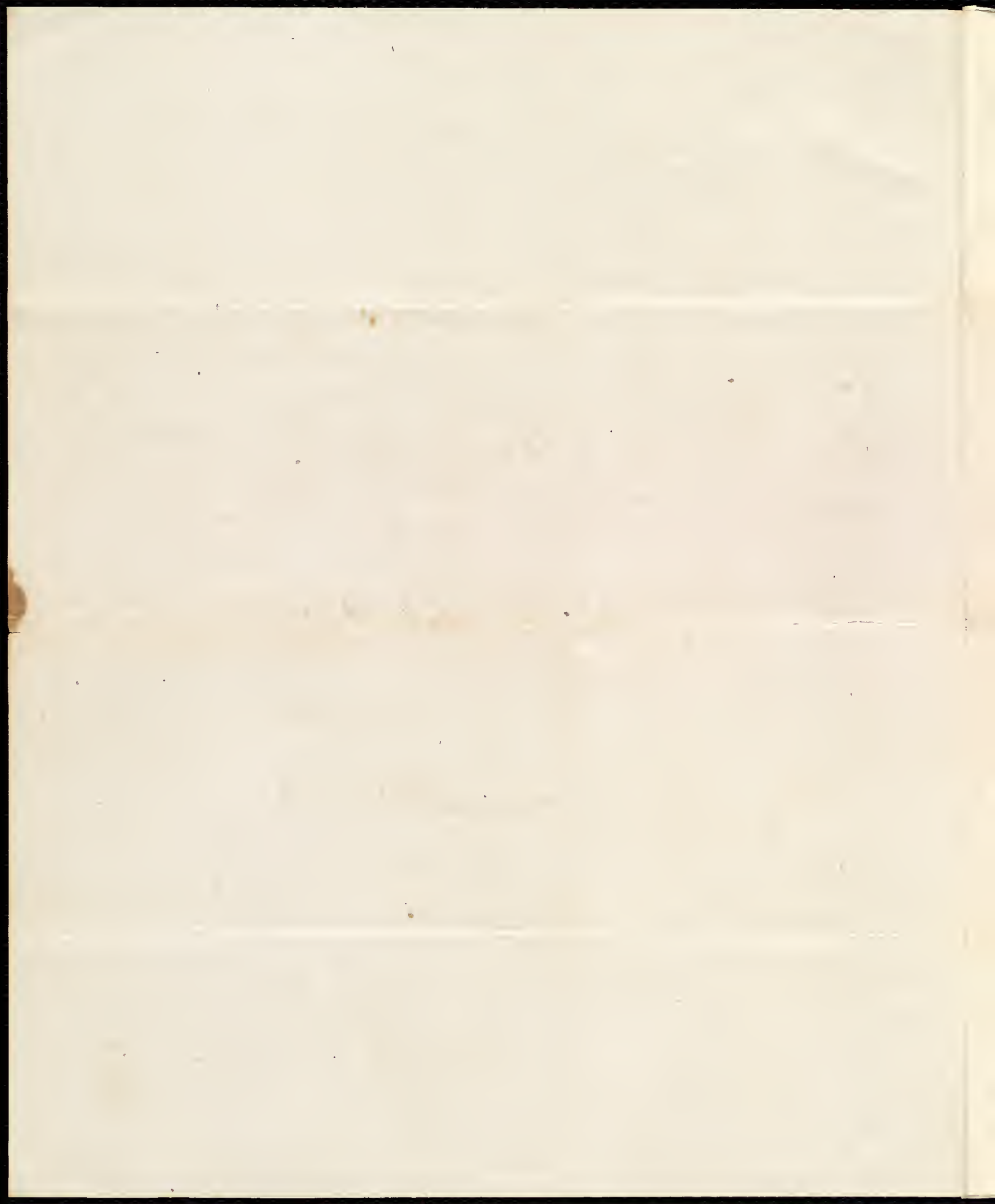
Dear Maria,

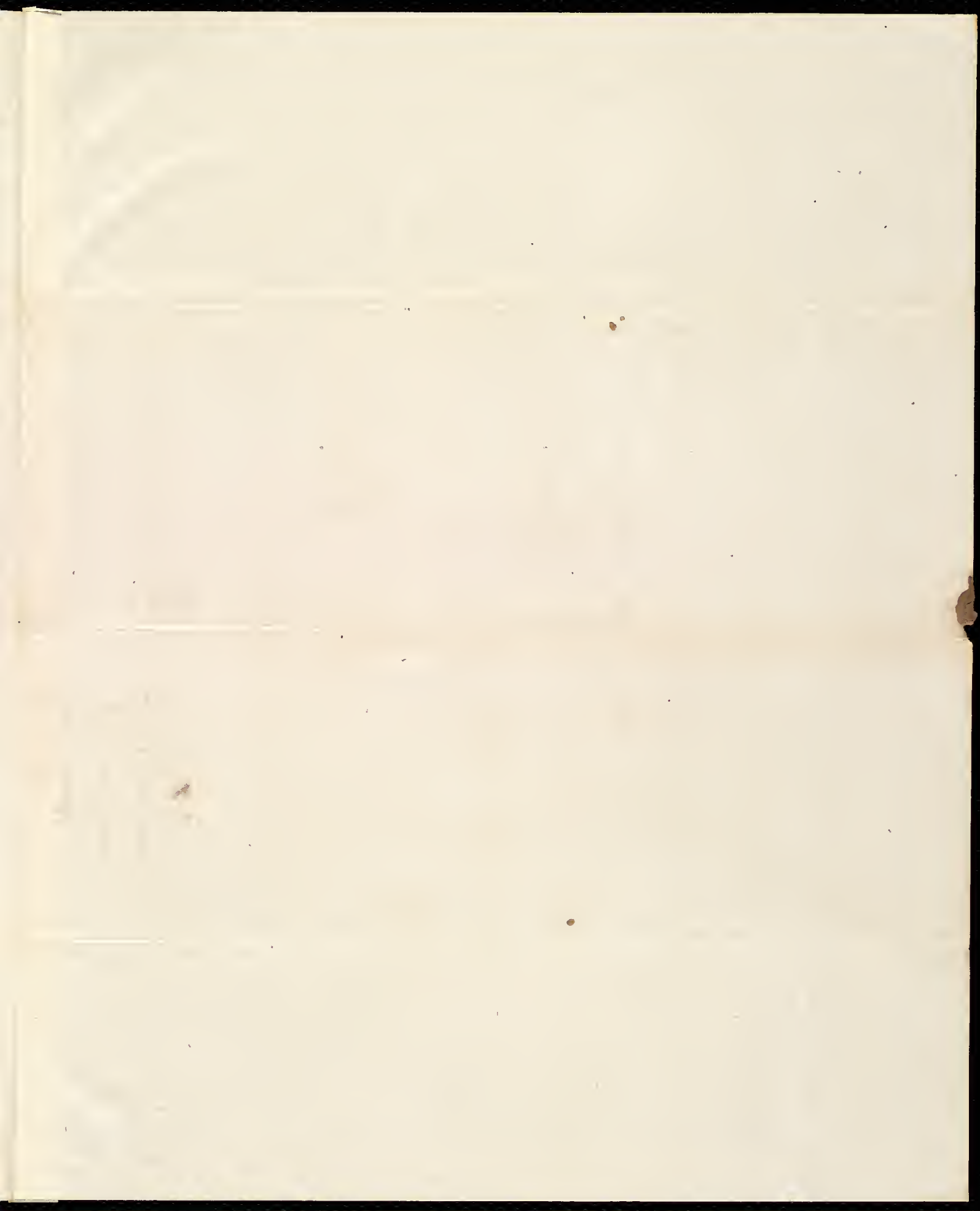
The inclosed money was collected
