Ferguson's Breeding Block of New Boykin Cotton, Photographed February 6, 1925. This is on one of the oldest farms in Grayson County, being patented in 1837. Its naturally thin land and the season was dry, as the small size of the stalks indicate, yet the average yield is about two thirds of a bale per acre, after being open 6 to 7 months. The large bolls still remain 99% Storm-Proof, and Easy to Pick. Adjacent Cotton was entirely harvested in one picking in November-December, making 38-42% lint turnout. This Breeding Block has been visited by more than 1000 persons during the fall and winter. The gentleman in the dark suit beside Mr. Ferguson is Mr. E. N. Boykin, who came to see the Breeding-Block of this cctton originated by Ferguson Seed Farms, and named to honor his father, Mr. W. L. Boykin, a pioneer seedsman.
