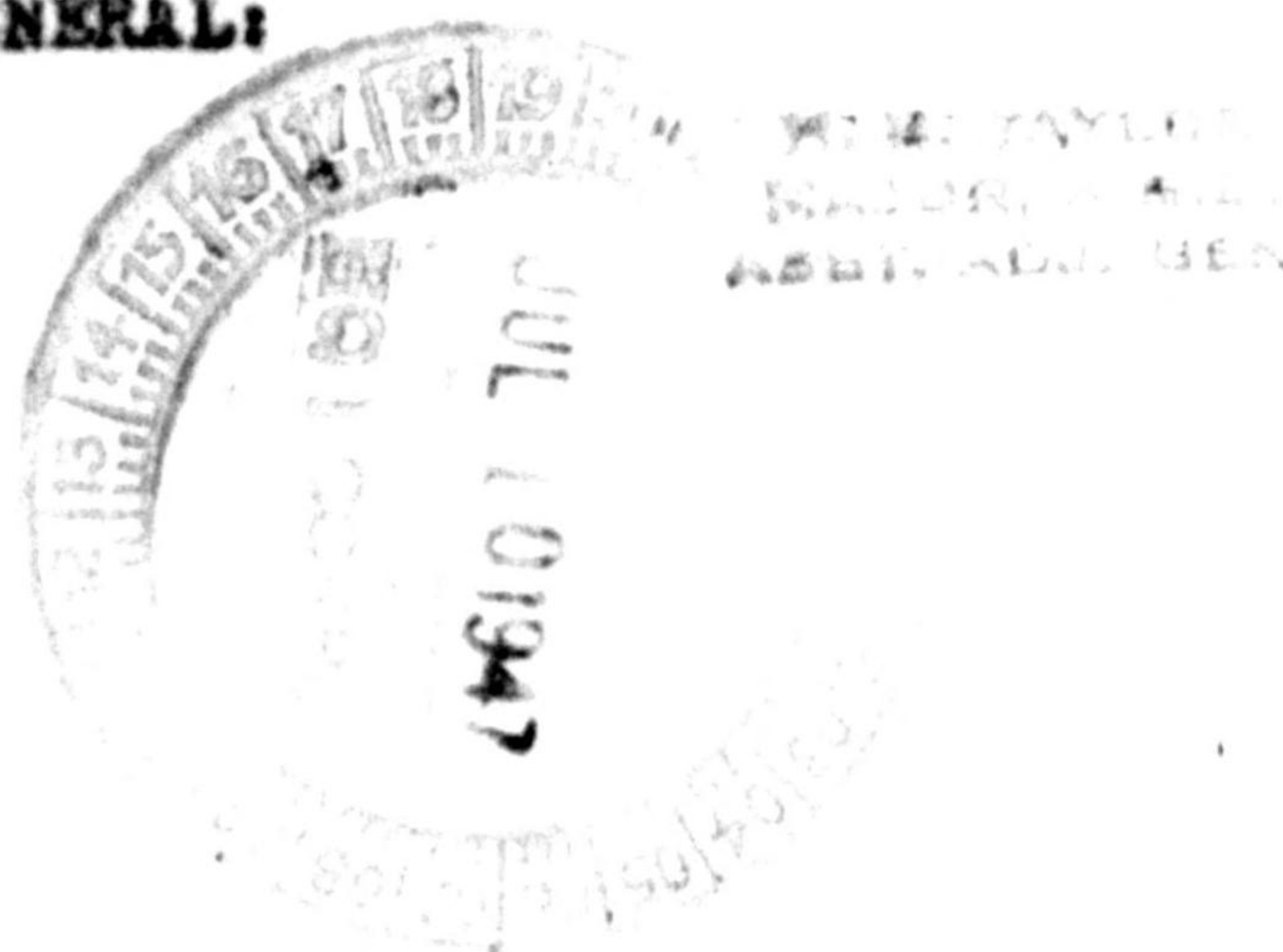

1. Equipment of subject company remaining at above address, and dispersed machines remaining in this prefecture were taken under custody 24 January.

2. The plant was leased in December 1945 to Kawai Gakki K.K. of Hamamatsu, to replace the latter firm's bombed out main plant in Hamamatsu, for the manufacture of furniture, musical instruments, and radio cabinets. Present production is radio cabinets and dependent housing furniture.

3. In December 1945 Nippon Kogaku K.K. received authorization from Hq 8th Army Military Gov't, Tokyo Det to remove the equipment of the Shimada plant to the main plant in Tokyo. All desired equipment was transferred, and the Shimada plant has been operated since April 1946 by the leasee.

4. Remaining equipment is approximately 70 items of which 60 are estimated to be of inventory interest. A Mr. T. Takagi, representative of Nippon Kogaku K.K., and a Mr. T.
