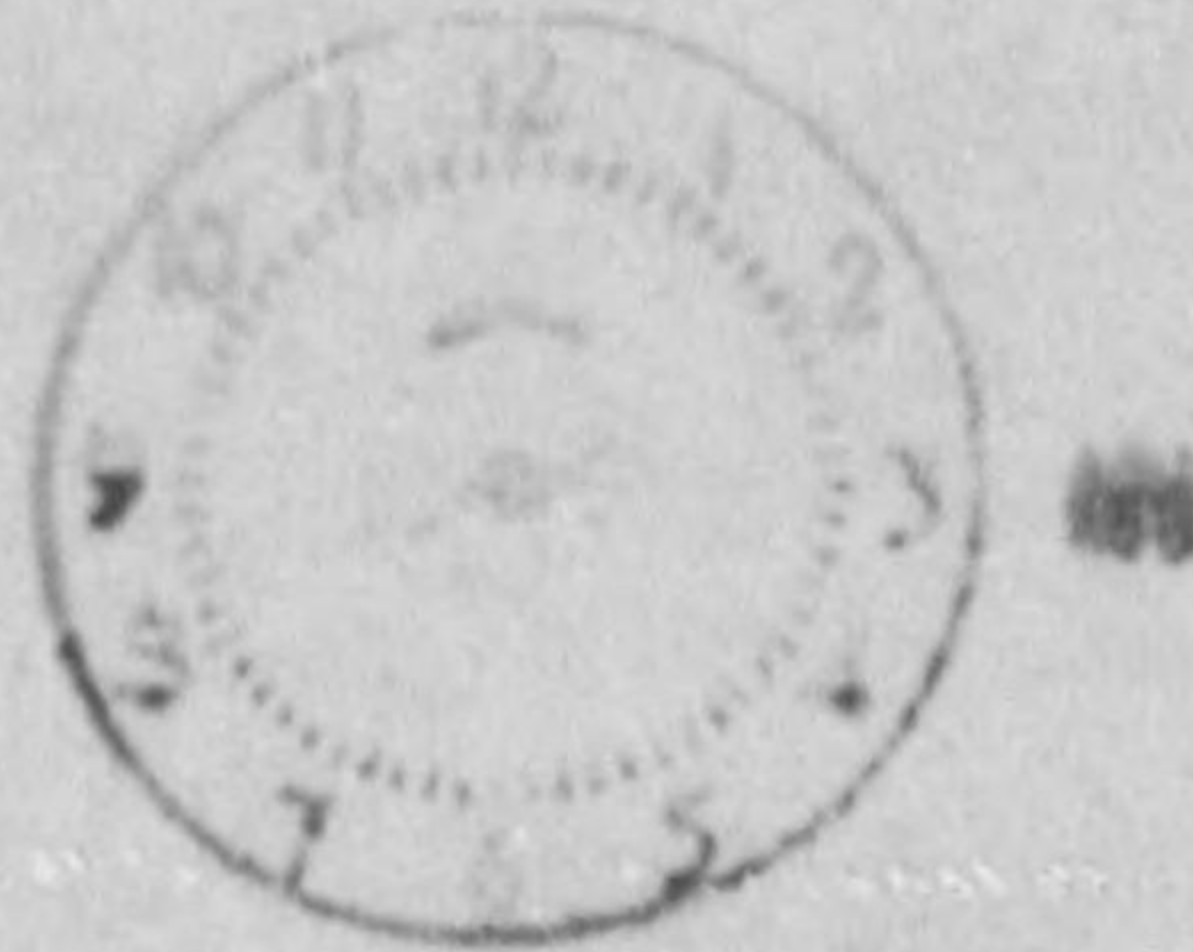

TEMPORARY INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

Training in Administration of Military Justice

1. A course of instruction on Administration of Military Justice is to be held for all officers (other than General Officers) and Warrant Officers on duty in the Office, Secretary of the Army and for those officers who join for duty with the Office, Secretary of the Army prior to 1 April 1949. The course will consist of the following:
 - a. A two (2) hour conference on the changes in the system of military justice occasioned by Public Law 759-80th Congress and embodied in the Manual for Courts-Martial, 1949 to be held 18 April 1949.
 - b. Required reading of the new Courts-Martial Manual by all personnel concerned.
 - c. A two (2) hour conference to review the changes incorporated in the new manual and to answer any individual questions. Date to be held will be announced at a later date.
2. The conferences prescribed in 1a and 1c above, will be held in the Signal Corps Auditorium, Room 5A 1070, The Pentagon, for all military personnel of the Office, Secretary of the Army as outlined in paragraph 1 above, on 18 April 1949 between the hours of 1730 and 1930. It is realized that absence for official or other reasons are bound to occur and will require the attendance of individuals at conferences other than that for which this office is scheduled. On 19 April 1949, the day following the conference, each division concerned will notify the Management Office (Mrs. Edith M. Campbell, Extension 5266) by phone of the number of absences from the scheduled conference and obtain a later conference date for those who were absent.
3. Upon completion of the training in Paragraph 1, each division will furnish each officer with a certificate indicating completion of the course. One copy will be furnished the individual and one copy placed in the individual's 201 file. Blank copies of the certificate will be furnished by the Management Office at a later date.
4. A copy of the new Manual of Courts-Martial will be made available to each officer for the self-study required in Paragraph 1b. Copies of these manuals will be distributed to each activity prior to the date of the conference; they must be returned to the Management Office, Room 3D-858, The Pentagon by 19 May 1949.

1. 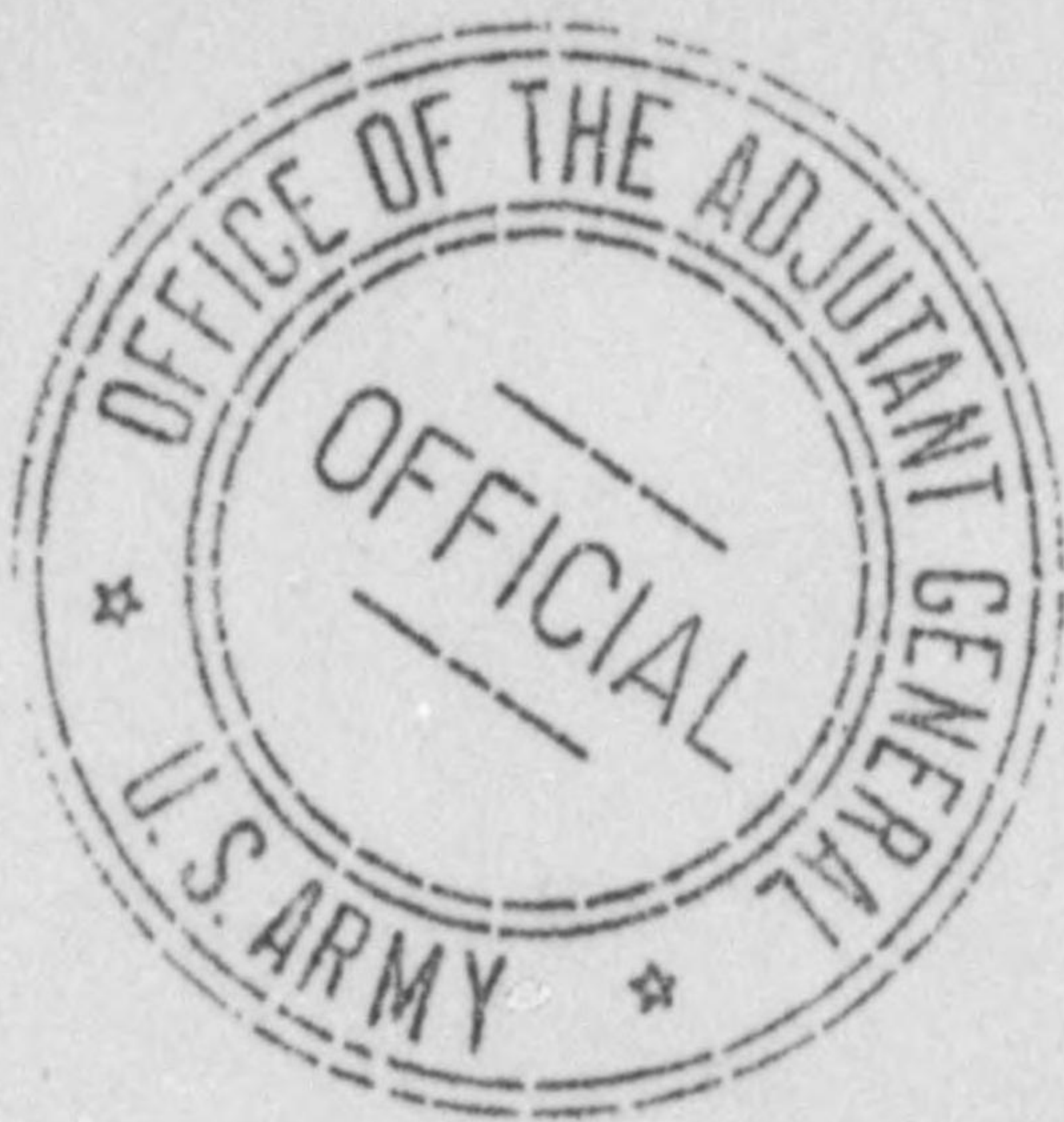

3. The following information is furnished as clarification of Department of the Army Memorandum No. 310-60-3, dated 20 September 1948, in view of the fact that the procedure outlined therein differs slightly for the Office, Secretary of the Army. It is requested that a Table of Distribution be prepared upon receipt of a change in military authorization by each activity in the Office, Secretary of the Army having military personnel and forwarded in duplicate to the Management Office, Office, Secretary of the Army, Room 3D-858, The Pentagon. Revised Tables of Distribution must be submitted to the Management Office within one month from the date of issuance of a revised military personnel authorization (OSA Form 77) or immediately upon the occurrence of a reorganization affecting the current T/D. Tables of Distribution must agree with the personnel authorization both in total number and number in each grade so authorized. The Management Office may be notified by phone, extension 5266, of all minor changes resulting from reorganization. It is imperative that T/D's on file in the Management Office be current at all times due to constant requests for information and reports compiled from them.
4. The attached sample T/D may be modified according to the needs of each organization. Where components of an organization are geographically separated or where an organization consists of both field and departmental activities, a separate "Section II-Organization" will be prepared for each component or activity. Branch of service designations will be left blank when a position does not require a specific branch. Section I- General of the Tables of Distribution, required by references mentioned heretofore, will not be prepared by activities within the Office, Secretary of the Army.
5. In order to eliminate the need for an additional report showing positions occupied by certain categories of personnel, Section II-Organization of the T/D's will indicate the following:
 - a. Positions occupied by WAC's will be indicated by the letter "W" in the left column of the table, preceding the line number.
 - b. Positions occupied by Negro personnel will be indicated by the letter "X" in the left column of the table, preceding the line number.

c. Positions occupied by WAC Negro personnel will be indicated by a double symbol, "W" in the left column of the table, preceding the line number.

6. Information pertaining to "Assignment to "for duty with GSUSA," appearing on Attachment 1, applies only to those division or offices in the Office, Secretary of the Army that are affected by Administrative Area Circular No. 11-9, dated 30 December 1947, subject: "Military Personnel Administration, General Staff Corps Status" (distributed and redesignated as OSA Office Memorandum No. 10-154).

7. Attachment 4 represents a list of T/D numbers which are authorized for use by activities of the Office, Secretary of the Army. One T/D number will apply to each complete set of Tables of Distribution, i. e. Section II-Organization and Section II-Recapitulation of SSN's. Each set, as submitted, should be numbered consecutively beginning with the first unused number in the series, or, in those cases wherein T/D'S are being submitted for the first time, beginning with the first number in the series. 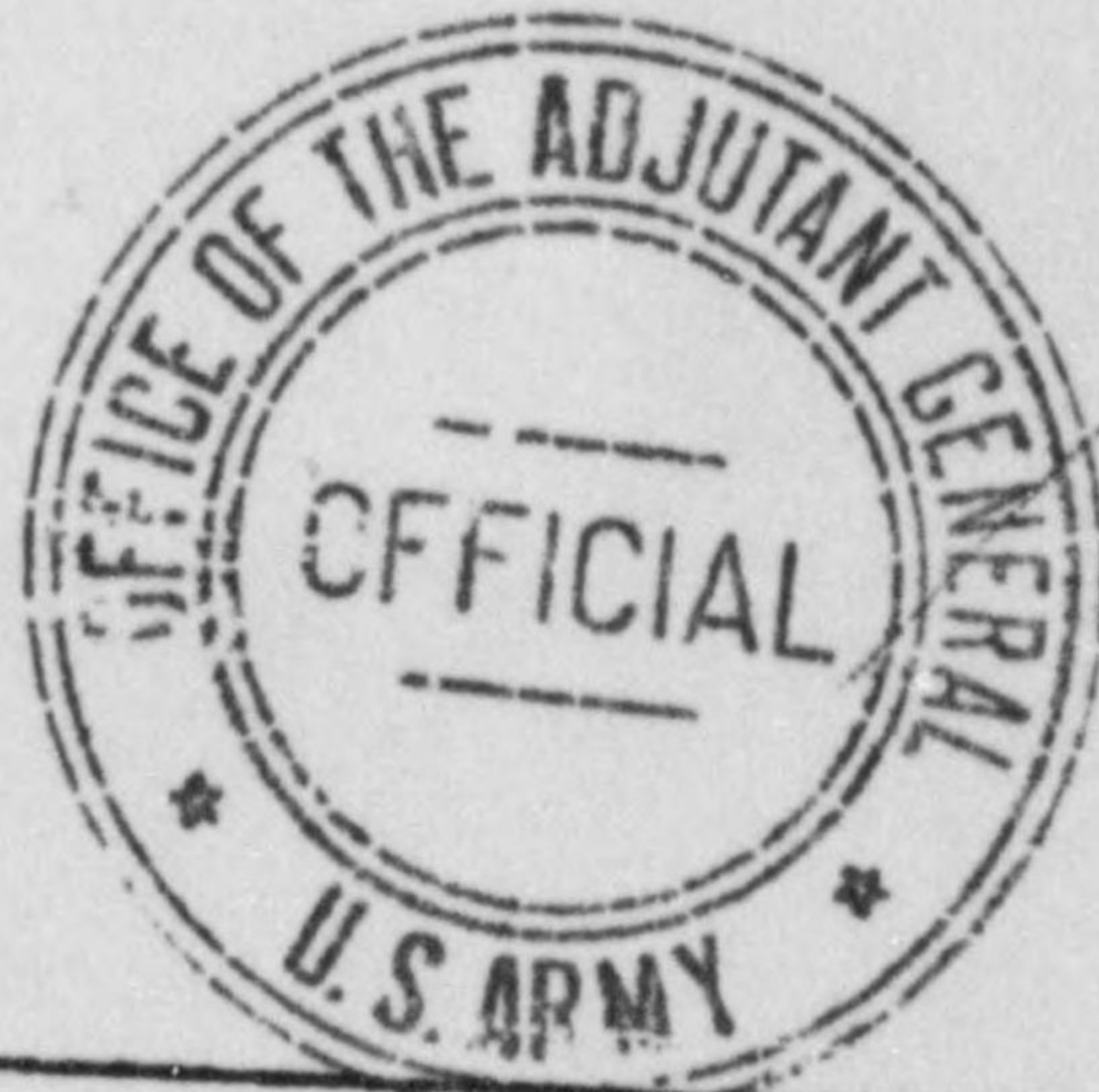



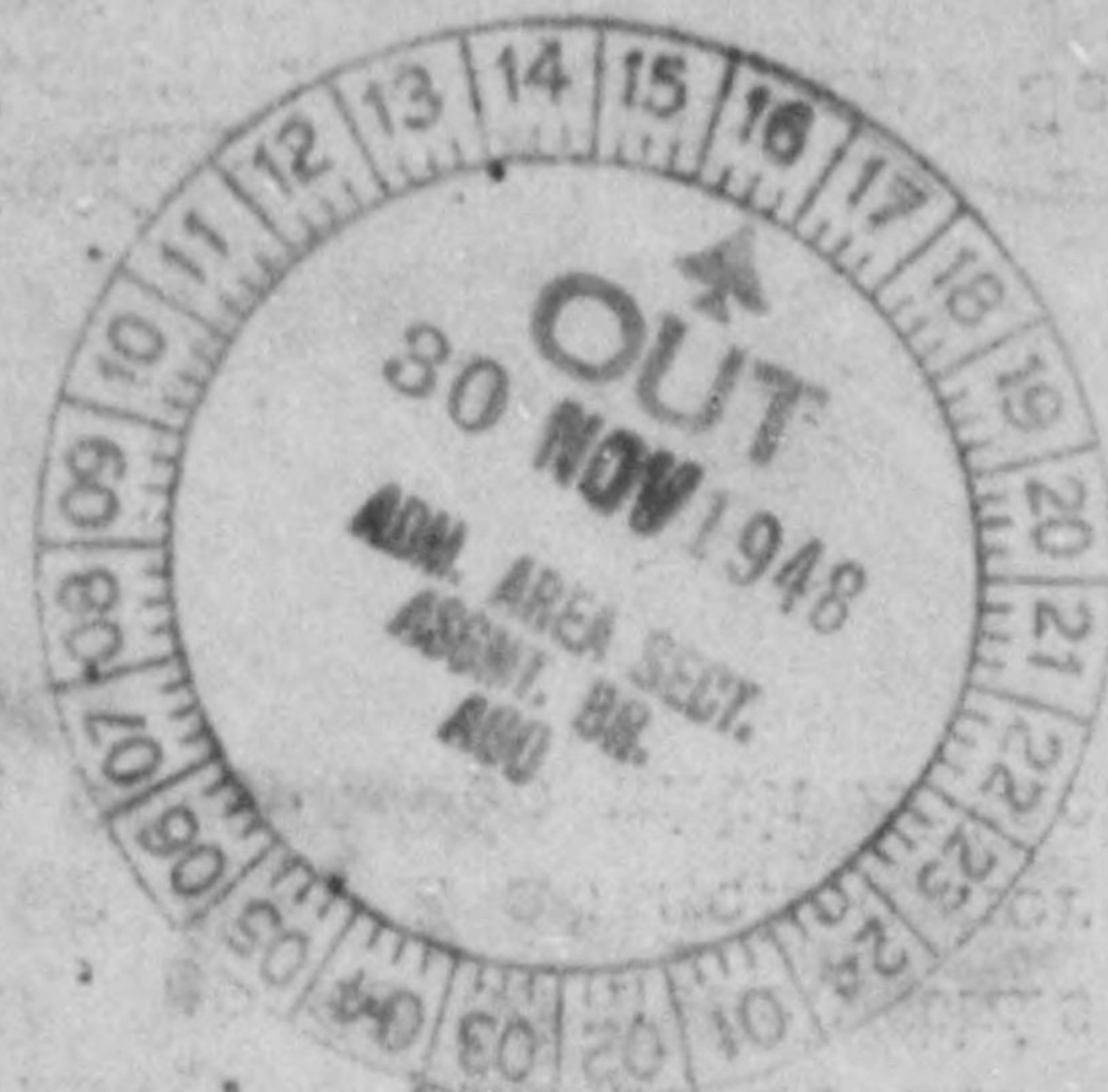

MILITARY PERSONNEL POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Tables of Distribution

1. OSA Office Memorandum No. 10-1 subject: Tables of Distribution, dated 14 June 1948, is hereby rescinded.
2. Reference is made to the following:
 - a. WD Memorandum 310-60-2, 19 May 1947
 - b. DA Memorandum No. 310-60-3, 20 September 1948
 - c. Change 1 to DA Memorandum No. 310-60-3, 4 October 1948
 - d. Technical Manual 20-410, April 1947
3. The following information is furnished as clarification of Department of the Army Memorandum No. 310-60-3, dated 20 September 1948, in view of the fact that the procedure outlined therein differs slightly for the Office, Secretary of the Army. It is requested that a Table of Distribution be prepared upon receipt of a change in military authorization by each activity in the Office, Secretary of the Army having military personnel and forwarded in duplicate to the Management Office, Office, Secretary of the Army, Room 3D-858, The Pentagon. Revised Tables of Distribution must be submitted to the Management Office within one month from the date of issuance of a revised military personnel authorization (OSA Form 77) or immediately upon the occurrence of a reorganization affecting the current T/D. Tables of Distribution must agree with the personnel authorization both in total number and number in each grade so authorized. The Management Office may be notified by phone, extension 5266, of all minor changes resulting from reorganization. It is imperative that T/D's on file in the Management Office be current at all times due to constant requests for information and reports compiled from them.
4. The attached sample T/D may be modified according to the needs of each organization. Where components of an organization are geographically separated or where an organization consists of both field and departmental activities, a separate "Section II-Organization" will be prepared for each component or activity. Branch of service designations will be left blank when a position does not require a specific branch. Section I- General of the Tables of Distribution, required by references mentioned heretofore, will not be prepared by activities within the Office, Secretary of the Army.
5. In order to eliminate the need for an additional report showing positions occupied by certain categories of personnel, Section II-Organization of the T/D's will indicate the following:
 - a. Positions occupied by WAC's will be indicated by the letter "W" in the left column of the table, preceding the line number.
 - b. Positions occupied by Negro personnel will be indicated by the letter "X" in the left column of the table, preceding the line number.

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c. Positions occupied by WAC Negro personnel will be indicated by a double symbol, "W" in the left column of the table, preceding the line number.

6. Information pertaining to "Assignment to "for duty with GSUSA," appearing on Attachment 1, applies only to those division or offices in the Office, Secretary of the Army that are affected by Administrative Area Circular No. 11-9, dated 30 December 1947, subject: "Military Personnel Administration, General Staff Corps Status" (distributed and redesignated as OSA Office Memorandum No. 10-154).

7. Attachment 4 represents a list of T/D numbers which are authorized for use by activities of the Office, Secretary of the Army. One T/D number will apply to each complete set of Tables of Distribution, i. e. Section II-Organization and Section II-Recapitulation of SSN's. Each set, as submitted, should be numbered consecutively beginning with the first unused number in the series, or, in those cases wherein T/D'S are being submitted for the first time, beginning with the first number in the series. For example, the Army Discharge Review Board will number its set thusly:

MILITARY PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATION

General Staff Corps Status

(This circular supersedes War Department Groups Circular No. 25-9, 22 July 1947, of the same title.)

1. DETAILED MEMBER OF GENERAL STAFF CORPS

a. Officers may be assigned as detailed members of the General Staff Corps to positions in the Office of the Chief of Staff and the divisions of the General Staff, United States Army.

- (1) *Number.* There is no restriction on the number of officers so assigned until the termination of the Act of 5 June 1942 (56 Stat. 314; 50 U.S.C. App., Sup. V., 762; M.L. 1939; Sup. III, Sec. 134, Note) as provided in Section 16 thereof. The provisions of this paragraph are not retroactive, but officers who are presently assigned and qualified within its scope may be made detailed members.

b. Requirements for *detail* to General Staff Corps:

- (1) *Position.* The position must be one involving duties relating to the formulation and coordination of basic principles, concepts, and General Staff plans for the military program of the Army. It is the responsibility of each General Staff Division to indicate on its current table of distribution the positions in the division which require detailed status in the General Staff Corps. Administrative or statistical positions are not included in this category. Each time a staff Division makes a change in the positions it allocates to detailed status, its table of distribution should be revised to indicate the change and then forwarded through the Organization and Training Division to Staff Administrative Office, Office of the Chief of Staff.
- (2) *Grade.* The officer must be captain or above.
- (3) *Request for Assignment.* A request for the *detail* of an officer as a member of the General Staff Corps will be addressed to the Staff Administrative Office, Office of the Chief of Staff. The communication will specifically request that the officer be "detailed as a member of the General Staff Corps," and will indicate the specific position to which the officer is to be assigned.
- (4) *Insignia.* The officer will wear the General Staff Corps insignia. After he has served one year as a detailed member of the General Staff

Corps, a certificate signed by the Secretary, General Staff will be forwarded to the head of the division to which the officer is assigned authorizing the latter to wear the General Staff Identification Device.

2. DUTY WITH THE GENERAL STAFF, UNITED STATES ARMY

a. Officers may be assigned for *duty with* the General Staff, United States Army to positions in the following agencies and activities of the Department of the Army Administrative Area (see also Memorandum 3-15-1, Department of the Army, 1947, "Personnel Authorization and Administration in the Department of the Army Administrative Area"):

- (1) *Secretary of Defense Area* (includes Joint Chiefs of Staff; Joint Staff; Munitions Board; Research and Development Board; Central Intelligence Agency; Army-Navy Explosives Safety Board; State-Army-Navy-Air Force Coordinating Committee; Joint Strategic Survey Committee; Joint Intelligence Objectives Agency; and United States Representation, Military Staff Committee, United Nations).
- (2) *Secretary of the Army Area* (includes Offices of the Secretary of the Army, Under Secretary of the Army, and Assistant Secretaries of the Army).
- (3) *Chief of Staff Area*
 - (a) Office of the Chief of Staff and divisions of the General Staff, United States Army—administrative, statistical, and other positions that are not "detailed status" positions.
 - (b) Special Staff, United States Army (except Office of the Inspector General and National Guard Bureau. Assignments to these agencies will be governed by paragraphs 5 b and c, AR 605-145).
- (4) *Miscellaneous Area and Foreign Assignment* (including Embassy Executive Office, Nanking, China; United States Advisory Mission to the Philippine Army; United States Military Mission, Iranian Army; United States Military Commission, Iranian Gendarmerie; Joint Brazil-United States Military Commission; United States Army Group, American Mission for Aid to Greece; United States Army Group, American Mission for Aid to Turkey; United States-Canada Interchange of Officers Group; Postwar Amphibian Staff Organizations).

b. Requirements for assignment to *duty with* the General Staff, United States Army:

(1) *Position*

- (a) Except as provided in (b) below, the position must contain the following duties: formulation or coordination of basic principles, concepts, and plans for the military program of the Army; or

service with, or close assistance to, the general (or comparable) staff sections of a foreign army; or service with another department or higher echelon of the National Military Establishment. The position must not be administrative or statistical in nature.

- (b) Administrative, statistical, and other positions in the Office of the Chief of Staff and in divisions of the General Staff that are not *detailed status* positions are *duty with* positions.
- (2) *Grade*. The officer must be a captain or above.
- (3) *Request for assignment*
- (a) A request for assignment to *duty with* the General Staff, United States Army, will be addressed to the Chief, Administrative Area Section, Assignment Branch, Office of the Adjutant General, Attention: AGP A-A, and will contain specific language as follows:
" x x x duty with the General Staff, United States Army" for a position in the Office, Chief of Staff or in a division of the General Staff, or " x x x duty with the General Staff, United States Army, for further duty with (the agency)" for positions in agencies and activities listed in paragraphs 2 a (1), (2), (3), and (4) above.
- (b) The request will be accompanied by a justification indicating how the particular duties contribute to the military program of the Army.
- (4) *Insignia*. The officer will wear the General Staff Corps insignia.

3. OFFICERS OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE

a. Officers of the United States Air Force who are or may be assigned to duty with the United States Army in the Department of the Army Administrative Area may be assigned to "duty with the General Staff" in accordance with the provisions of this circular provided authority for assignment is granted by the Chief of Staff, United States Air Force.

- (1) (1) *Insignia*. United States Air Force officers assigned to duty with the General Staff, may not wear the General Staff Corps insignia.
- (2) *Identification Device*. A United States Air Force officer detailed as a member of the General Staff Corps and assigned to the "War Department" General Staff prior to the issuance of Transfer Order Number I shall be granted authority to wear the General Staff Identification Device upon completion of one year of service providing he had been detailed to the General Staff Corps prior to 26 September 1947 and since that time has been assigned as an Air Force officer to duty with the General Staff in the same agency to which he had previously been detailed as a member of the General Staff Corps.

TO: Commanders of all agencies and organizations serviced by the 7th Machine Records Unit, SAB, AGO.

1. Department of the Army, AGO, letter, AGAM-PM 320.2 (25 Aug 48), AGAS-F, dated 26 August 1948, subject, Personnel Survey of the Army (Reports Control Symbol CSGPA-35), requires that Personnel Survey Interview Forms (DA AGO Form R-5506) be completed for approximately 5 per cent of all personnel of the Army. The survey will include only Department of the Army commissioned officers, warrant officers, and enlisted personnel assigned to Department of Army organizations whose serial numbers end in 19, 37, 55, 73 and 91. These instructions do not apply to Department of Air Force personnel assigned to duty with the Department of the Army.

2. Personnel Survey Interview Forms will be completed for all personnel with serial numbers ending in the above-mentioned numbers who are assigned to your organization as of 30 SEPTEMBER 1948, excluding noneffectives and pipeline personnel assigned to reassignment centers.

3. Attention is directed to Joint Army and Air Force Adjustment Regulations 1-1-1, 13 November 1947, Determination and Departmental Status, which establishes serial number prefixes as a means of identification in determining departmental status. The serial number prefix, as indicated in Section IV of cited regulation, will become a permanent part of the assigned serial number of each individual and will change only in case of a subsequent departmental transfer. The proper serial number prefix will be reported for all personnel included in the survey.

4. Items 20, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32 are to be established by interview of the individuals concerned since current data are required rather than data reflected on the Soldier's Qualification Card, WD AGO Form 20; the WAC Qualification Card, WD AGO Form 720 and qualification cards for other personnel. After verification of qualification cards of all personnel, other items may be obtained from the items indicated on the card. Where codes are available on the qualification cards, they may be entered in preference to descriptions. If codes are not available, sufficient description will be entered to allow machine records units to code these data. The section headed "Remarks" will be used to indicate reasons complete data are not furnished and for any remarks that may be appropriate for clarification of data indicated.

5. The Personnel Survey Interview Forms, both complete and incomplete as to required information, will be authenticated and returned to the Office

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PERSONNEL SURVEY OF THE ARMY INTERVIEW FORM

- NOTE 1: The serial number prefix as established for adoption by JAAFAR 1-1-1, 1947, as amended, will be indicated for each individual represented in the survey. The prefix, as indicated in section IV, JAAFAR 1-1-1, will become a permanent part of the assigned serial number. This is absolutely necessary in order to identify properly individuals as to their assignment as Army or Air Force personnel.
- NOTE 2: a. Months in present grade for officer personnel will be total months in grade in which serving from "date of rank" through 30 September 1948.
b. Months in present grade for enlisted personnel will be total months in grade from "date of current grade" through 30 September 1948. Less than a month in present grade will be computed as one month.
- NOTE 3: Officers on duty with, but who are not members of the Philippine Scouts will be reported in proper component; i.e., Army of the United States, Organized Reserve Corps, National Guard, or Regular Army.
- NOTE 4: Indicate the actual number of years of school completed. Graduates from grammar school will be credited with 8 years; high school, 12 years; college, 16 years; post graduate, the number of years of post graduate work completed plus 16 years for grammar school, high school, and college. When an individual has completed only 2 years of high school, number of years of education credited will be 10.
- NOTE 5: "Military service" is defined as service in the United States Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard, or any component thereof. For the purpose of this survey partial month's service will be computed as 1 month.
- NOTE 6: Active service in State National Guard not included in items 15 or 16, but is included in item 18.
- NOTE 7: Service to be included is inactive Federal and other inactive service applicable in determining longevity pay; other service includes non-federalized National Guard (other than National Guard of the United States in Federal service) National Guard Reserve and inactive National Guard if counted for longevity pay.
- NOTE 8: In computing the total number of months of oversea service it is important the computation be made so as to provide the information desired. For example, for this survey (number 20), which is as of 30 September 1948, the maximum number of months that could possibly be indicated is 82 (the 24-day period in December 1941 is computed as 1 month). For the purpose of this survey, partial month's service will be computed as 1 month.

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NOTE 9: In computing leave as of 30 September 1948, for the purpose of this survey, accrued leave computed at more than 60 days for any individual will be reported as 60 days only.

NOTE 10: All officers are in receipt of rental and/or subsistence; consequently this item requires a positive answer by each officer interviewed in accordance with current survey.

NOTE 11: a. Only enlisted men of the combat ground forces who have been awarded the expert infantryman badge or combat infantryman badge are entitled to additional pay therefor, except as explained in (b) below. Any enlisted men who have been awarded the Medical Badge are entitled to additional pay therefor, except as explained in (b) below.

b. Personnel in a above are ineligible to receive additional pay for the medals indicated when:

- (1) They are in a nonpay status.
- (2) Their award has been revoked.
- (3) They are receiving additional pay for--
 - (a) Expert infantryman badge, medical badge, flying or diving duty (applicable to holders of combat infantryman badge).
 - (b) Combat infantryman badge, medical badge, flying or diving duty (applicable to holders of expert infantryman badge).
 - (c) Expert or combat infantryman badge, flying or diving duty (applicable to holders of medical badge).
