

1. Reference letter this headquarters, AG 400 (13 Feb 52)GA, subject: Termination of Logistic Support and Use of Military Payment Certificates in Japan, dated 13 February 1952.

2. Action required by sub-paragraph 2d reference letter terminating certain types of logistic support as of 29 February 1952 will be suspended until 10 March 1952 or earlier if notified otherwise, for the following:

1. REFERENCE: FEAF msg AX 7353 OP-CP4, 1 Dec 51.
2. At the present time, there is no legal agency of the Japanese Government charged with coordinating the participation of communities and rural areas adjacent to US military bases in practice passive air defense matters. Japanese passive air defense plans which are being formulated will include a central government agency responsible for passive air defense measures with subagencies in the prefectures. All commands will be notified when these arrangements have been finalized.
3. Participation of the Japanese civil population is on a voluntary basis and authority is not delegated to require Japanese civil participation in practice air alerts. CINCFE interposes no objection to local military commanders making such cooperative arrangements as possible with Japanese civil agencies for coordinated practice passive air defense measures. The present practice of limiting practice alerts to the immediate vicinity of participating airbases is approved.
4. Until implementing laws for participation by the civilian population in air defense measures are passed by the Japanese government, the requirement that CINCFE be notified of practice air alerts a minimum of eight days in advance remains in effect.



FEC Cir 31, 17 Jun 50, Application for Travel of Dependents, includes provisions for tvl of deps based on pvt rental. EM below grade E-5 are not entitled to O/S trans of deps, as confirmed by CINCCE rad ZX 28967, 9 Dec 50.

Rescinded para defined military personnel of grades E-5 and above as eligible to secure approved private rental housing in the Far East Command. This has been interpreted by some agencies as restricting military personnel below E-5 from entering into private rental agreements.

Para 9a, SCAP Cir 27, '49 prohibited EM below grade E-5 entering into pvt rental agreements. SCAP ltr AG 601 (11 Jan 50)GA, Private Rental Agreements, dtd 11 Jan 50, modified this restriction to be applicable only to those EM not eligible to receive qrs allowance. Career Compensation Act of 1949 authd EM in grade E-4 with 7 or more yrs service a qrs allowance and the Dependents Assistance Act of 1950 authorizes qrs allowance for EM of all grades with dops.

Thus under provisions of private rental agreement authority, an enlisted man of any grade with dops present in theater may under appropriate circumstances secure housing through private rental.

Rescission made applicable only to major commands in Japan since specific private rental authority is effective in Japan only.

No change in policy is involved.
