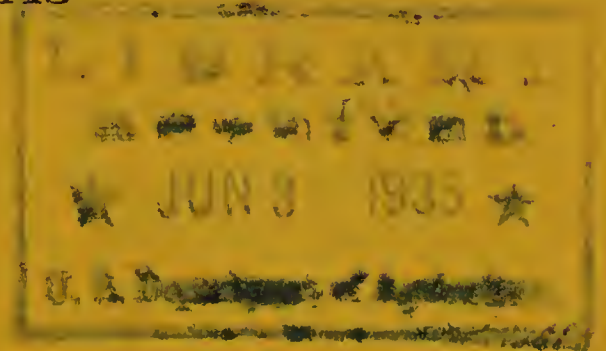

## EVERBLOOMING HECKROTTI HONEYSUCKLE.

Constantly in bloom from June until killing frost, heavy dark green foliage which remains until mid-winter. Flowers, bright red with deep yellow throat, very showy and fragrant. Can either be grown as a shrub by trimming or can be grown as a vine for trellises, porches, etc. This plant is rapidly gaining in popularity from year to year, the past season, despite the drought, it was in full bloom thru out the summer and sold in bloom, balled and burlaped, at \$2.00 per plant.
