1. Hans HERRSCHAFT, a former SS-Untersturmführer and Obersturn of the SD, is living at Aschau-Werk, Muhlendorf/Inn. He is reported to have collaborated closely on the work undertaken by Dr. MARCUX in the R.S.V. (a pro-Soviet movement). He further is reported to be vice president of the "Association of Germans of Rumania."

2. At the end of the war, he is alleged to have registered at Munich as a displaced person. At that time, he is reported to have had at his disposal large sums of money acquired from his work for the Rumanian Seguransa. His wife, a Rumanian citizen, allegedly left her country in 1949 with a great deal of luggage containing considerable gold and jewels.

3. For a while, he reportedly worked with a certain BAUMSCHEN, who claims to be a professor and lives at Munich, Ismaningerstrasse, No. 102 (telephone 48,11,01) for an office of the C.I.D. in Munich. As a displaced person, he allegedly obtained, shortly thereafter, the direction of a brick factory located at Muhlendorf/Inn. Reportedly, he profited from this position to acquire a certain standing among the displaced persons whom he represented. In this connection, he allegedly was received on several occasions by Professor HEUSS and by the president of the federal parliament Herr EHLER.

4. As the firm which he directed allegedly went bankrupt, Subject reportedly decided to return to his work for the Siguransa.

1. Reference dispatch contained information received from [ ] concerning Hans HERRSCHAF, currently reported to be working for the Rumanian Siguranta, and requested information which might tend to confirm the material submitted by source.

The following information which corroborates some details furnished by [ ] has been extracted from MGLA-10613 dated 3 March 1952, subject: Dr. Emil HOFFMANN, an individual allegedly participating in illegal East-West trade:

Hans HERRSCHAF, Rumanian Volkdeutch, former SS-Untersturm-fuhrer, is living at Puhldorf/Im - Aschau-Werk. An historian, he is a silent partner in a glass tile factory. He has been involved in shady affairs in connection with bills of exchange. He has a contact in MIKROKOPIE, a firm in Munich; in the French Intelligence Service; and in "Scheinwerfer-Kreis" (sic).

With reference to Dr. MARCUX and his association with the RSU (Rhineland Recording Statistical Unit), MGLA-10613 stated that one Dr. Karl MARKUS, assistant leader of Bureau J (RSHA section engaged in economic intelligence) who defected to the British in France in 1944, belonged to the RSU after 1945. In this capacity he recruited earlier members of the German IS, of the SS and of the Nazi Party for his net. He used as cover for himself and his recruits the fact that they were all former members of a resistance group in the Third Reich.

MGLA-10613 listed both HERRSCHAF and MARKUS as contacts of HOFFMANN but did not state these two were known to each other.

3. There is no information in headquarters' files indicating that HERRSCHAF has been connected with the RSJ nor is there any additional information about that "movement" itself.

4. In connection with the "Association of Germans of Rumania," it was reported in MUNI-6226 dated 27 December 1951 that Herwart SCHEINER's "Association of Germans from Rumania" had voted on 11 September 1951 in Munich to join the "League of Free Rumanians" which has strong Iron Guard orientation. Hans HERRSCHAF was appointed by the Association one of four representatives to the League from Germany. According to the Rumanian Desk, the League is a loose organization in which member groups appear to have retained some of their identity, and it is plausible that HERRSCHAF is vice-president of the "Association of Germans from Rumania" as reported by [ ]

5. While there is no evidence here to substantiate [ ] report that HERRSCHAF is working or has worked for the Rumanian Siguranta, the possibility need not be ruled out. It has been reported that he has an unsavory reputation and has been involved in blackmarket activities.

6. Headquarters has no record of BAUMSCHEN nor any information indicating that HERRSCHAF has been received by Professor HEUSS or by Herr EHLER. It is felt that Frankfurt might be able to furnish information concerning these contacts.

7. There is no objection to your passing to [ ] the information in paragraphs 4 and 5. The German Desk has granted permission for the transmittal to liaison of the information in paragraph 2; however, the Desk has pointed out that this material has been secured from ZIPPER and that, therefore, source may have also distributed it to the French. The decision whether or not to pass this information to [ ] is left to your discretion.

8. Headquarters feels that Frankfurt may be able to provide additional information concerning HERRSCHAF. Should any evidence come to your attention supporting the allegation that he is presently working for the Siguranta (which has been incorporated into the SECURITATE), headquarters would appreciate receiving this information.

Headquarters Action Required: None; for information and files.

1. The following information was provided by [ ] on a contact made by Hans HERRSCHAFT with Emmerich STOFFEL, Charge d'Affaires at the Rumanian Legation in Bern:

a. Sometime during the week of 3-9 June 1956, Hans HERRSCHAFT went to Bern to see the Rumanian Charge d'Affaires, Emmerich STOFFEL. His object was to obtain from the latter, a Swabian from the Banat, a (letter of) recommendation for the SORICE firm in Frankfurt in order to enable him to do business with this firm. Subject did not provide [ ] any information concerning the nature of his business.

b. According to Subject, the interview allegedly took place in the following manner: Without having written or telephoned in advance, he went to Bern, Schlosslistrasse 7, and requested permission at the Rumanian Legation Chancellery to see Emmerich STOFFEL. Following a five minute wait and after having provided his identity, Subject was led by a certain (fnu) ALEXIU into the Charge's office. The latter received HERRSCHAFT very courteously and asked,

"You are from Gattenbrunn?"

"Yes, but how do you know?"

"Through Mr. (fnu) GHELTZ and through the refugee press. Do you wish to repatriate?"

"No, Mr. Minister. I have a situation in Germany and I am not thinking about repatriating. The object of my visit is of another character." (Subject then explained, half in German, half in Rumanian, the reasons for his arrival in Bern.)

c. (In German) STOFFEL said, "You have come to the right place, for our commercial branch office in Frankfurt depends on me. We wish to activate our trade with the German Federal Republic and we need a lot of collaborators. We are thinking, first of all, about Germans, natives of Rumania, for they are more familiar with the particular circumstances of our country. We are thinking about using them with no discrimination of a political or social nature. I know your family in Rumania; it has accustomed itself to the new state of things, and I shall willingly recommend you to our friends in Frankfurt/Main."

d. After stating this, STOFFEL called in a certain Dr. BOGDAN, with whom Subject discussed in detail the nature of the commercial affairs which he wished to handle with the Frankfurt branch. Before leaving, STOFFEL suggested to HERRSCHAF that the latter visit him any time he wished.

e. On his return from Bern, Subject went to the branch office (SORICE) in Frankfurt. There he learned that STOFFEL had indeed intervened on his behalf, for the presumed chief of the firm, a certain IONESCU, was very courteous with him. Subject received from the latter assurance that he would be included on the list of those to whom orders would be passed first of all.

2. [ ] provided the following background data on Subject: Hans HERRSCHAF, agriculturist by profession, native of Guttenbrunn, region of ARAD, Rumania, currently a business representative of the firm LIBRO-EXPORT. His mother's cousin is none other than Filip GHELTZ, also a Swabian, member of the Central Committee of the Rumanian Communist Party. GHELTZ was recently appointed a Minister in the Bucharest Government.

3. [ ] is only a casual acquaintance of Subject. We feel that this might be a lead worth exploiting and will press him to obtain additional details on HERRSCHAF. A separate dispatch requesting traces on Subject and his cousin, Filip GHELTZ, and containing any MOB-POB traces, will be forwarded.

4. [ ] Please note that, as in reference A, STOFFEL once again expressed himself in German. We are uncertain as to how well HERRSCHAF speaks Rumanian; however, if he speaks the language fluently, we also wonder at STOFFEL's choice of language. This may be worth looking into.

Prior to 1939 SUBJECT was the leader of the Volksdeutschen (ethnic Germans) in Rumania. In the late thirties he studied at the Berlin Hochschule fuer Politik for several semesters, was a member of the Waffen-SS and a coworker of the SD (Sicherheitsdienst - Security Service).

In 1948 SUBJECT came to the Federal Republic as a refugee. Until 1953 he resided in A,chau, Muehldorf Landkreis; since 24 October 1953 he has been living in Munich at various addresses. His present address is Schneeglöckchenstrasse no. 73.

From 1950 to 1952 SUBJECT was a member of the Verband der Deutschen aus Rumänien (Union of the Germans from Rumania) and a coworker of the monthly "Brücke aus Westen" (published by that Union). In 1954 he wrote for the leftist paper "Deutsche Nationalzeitung".

Recently SUBJECT repeatedly participated in meetings held by the organization "Deutsche Nationalversammlung" (VDN).

Presently he claims to be a co-worker of the neutralist periodical "Neue Politik". He was present at the trial of Dr. Hans KÄFFINGER in Passau, allegedly at the request of Wolf SCHEMKE, publisher of the "Neue Politik".

Available information indicates that SUBJECT is making efforts to establish contact with various functionaries of rightist groups, without himself becoming active in these organizations.

The LFV requests to be furnished all information available in regard to SUBJECT, especially such concerning possible intelligence contacts.
