Doc. # 1593 INTERNATIONAL MILITARY TRIBUNAL FOR THE FAR EAST THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, et al - VS -ARAKI Sadao, et al - Defendants -AFFIDAVIT Hayashi Kaoru I, Hayashi Kaoru, after having been duly sworn according to the Japanese formula, make the following statement of my own free will: 1. I am 39 years old and reside in Tokyo, Oota-ku, Denenchofu, 2-Chome, 808 Banchi, Tokyo. 2. I have been since August 1946 Chief of the Archives Section of the Secretariat of the Japanese Foreign Ministry, and as such have custody of documents and archives of the Foreign Office. 3. I have made a thorough search of all the archives and files of the Foreign Office for documents relating to the Chang-ku-feng Border Incident including originals, copies and drafts of telegrams, letters, messages and other communications, opinions and manuscripts. 4. I have been unable to find any of the documents referred to in paragraph 3 of this affidavit. An official record of the Foreign Office shows that all files relating to this incident were destroyed by fire, and I believe that this is so. 5. The records of the Foreign Office do not indicate that any of such documents were delivered to the International Prosecution Sect on, the Washington Document Center nor to any other persons. 20 May 1947, at Tokyo K.
