TO : Commanding General, I Corps, APO 301

1. Transmitted herewith are copies of reports of inspection of property belonging to the Rising Sun Petroleum Company in your zone of responsibility made by a representative of the Petroleum Advisory Group, G-4, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, in company with a representative of the Civil Property Custodian, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. In those instances where the inspection reports disclose that the Japanese Government is failing to perform minimum maintenance necessary to prevent deterioration of property, action should be taken under the provisions of Operational Directive 48, 9 June 1947, this headquarters, subject: "Surveillance of Preservation and Protection of Property of United Nations Nationals," to require the Japanese prefectural government to properly discharge its responsibility.

SUBJECT: Sale of Moveable Property Belonging to 1200 Repatriated "Objectionable Germans".

TO: Commanding Officer, Kinki Military Government Region, APO 301

From 22 March to 25 March 1948 a conference was attended at CPC, Tokyo, for the purpose of discussing procedure of "disposal by sale" of German property now stored in Eighth Army Warehouses.

For a number of months a disposal program of this property has been under study by G-1, G-4, CPC, CI & E, PH & W, CPC, ESS, Diplomatic Section and Special Service, GHQ. After many conferences by representatives of the above sections and considerable radio communication with the German External Property Commission, Washington, D.C., a Staff Study on the program was submitted to and approved by the Chief of Staff, GHQ. A summary of the Staff Study is submitted for your information:

SUMMARY OF STAFF STUDY

Property belonging to 1200 repatriated Germans impounded and stored at:

- a. Setagaya, Tokyo
- b. Kurihama, Uraga, Kanagawa
- c. Nakanoshima, Osaka

Type of Property:

- a. Clothing: including all types of wearing apparel, table linens, bedding, bolts of silk and wool.
- b. Furniture: including all types of household furniture. Antiques, well preserved Korean, Chinese or Japanese pieces. Lacquer ware, picture frames.
- c. Other Items: Automobiles, pianos, refrigerators, typewriters, medical instruments, phonograph records, cameras, projectors, kakemono (scrolls) oil paintings, sporting goods, books, clocks and sail boats.
- d. Items to be retained which do not depreciate substantially and are therefore not subject to disposal at this time:

China ware, silver ware, cutlery, metal ware, glass ware, jewelry, special items of art of high intrinsic value, such as cloisonne, photographs, albums and personal papers.

Method of Disposal:

- a. Sealed bid or auction
- b. Donation to welfare
- c. Destruction

Method of Classification:

- a. Sold for American Dollars or acceptable foreign exchange other than Yen.
- b. Sold for Yen
- c. Non-deteriorable merchandise to be stored (pending further disposition instructions from GEPC)
- d. Donation or destruction:

Note: In the best interest of the GEPC nations attempt will be made to obtain the highest possible proceeds. This is possible only on a bid or auction basis and precludes negotiated sale of any sort, except in the case of sale for Yen where prices must of necessity fall within the existing price control structure of the Japanese Government.

Sales Procedure:

- a. Publicity, advertising in the Stars and Stripes, bulletins and radio, acquainting all Occupation personnel of the sale.
- b. Property will be made available for inspection to prospective purchasers for a period of three weeks.
- c. Forms will be provided prospective purchasers for making sealed bids which will be placed in locked boxes at the site of the sale.
- d. Highest bidders will be determined by a board of officers representing the Inspector General and the Civil Property Custodian.
- e. Auction sales, provided they are found necessary in some instances, will be handled by open and competitive bidding conducted by the auctioneer and each article will be sold to the highest bidder.
- f. Strict property accounting will be maintained by CPC

Persons Eligible to Purchase:

- a. Sale for Dollars or other acceptable foreign exchange other than Yen:  
All members of the Occupation, including licensed commercial entrants or other United Nations nationals, including clubs, units, organizations.
- b. Sale for Yen:  
Only persons selected on a fair basis by the Japanese Government.

Display Room:

- a. CPC contemplates keeping the warehouses open for inspection of displays of saleable merchandise for a three week period, 7 days per week. This will enable Occupation personnel to visit the display warehouses on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons and Sundays.
- b. An individual would be enabled to submit any number of bids on one visit to the warehouse in the case of sales on a sealed bid basis, whereas, in sales by auction, an individual, in order to obtain a specific item could conceivably be required to be present at the sale for a matter of days awaiting appearance of that item.
- c. CPC proposes to sell by auction such specialized items as may have a demand among only a small group of potential purchasers. This may include such property as surgical tools, technical books, etc.

There is a total of some 250 railroad cars or 25,000 individual items to be disposed of. While it is impossible to estimate the rapidity of sale by auction, it is obvious that not more than 360 items could be sold in a 6 hour/day even at the optimistic rate of one sale per minute. At this rate, approximately 70 days of continuous selling would be required to dispose of all items, since in order to afford all purchasers equal opportunity, only one sale could be conducted, thus precluding concurrent sales. In addition there is not sufficient personnel available to CPC to conduct an auction sale of this magnitude. Further, sale by auction would necessitate moving all individual items to the auction site. A survey of warehouses indicates that facilities are not available to provide for crowds of purchasers.

Responsibility:

Responsibility for the surveillance of this sale rests with SCAP as ordered by the Department of the Army and has been delegated by SCAP to Civil Property Custodian.

Degree of Responsibility:

CPC will be responsible for the following:

- a. Determining articles to be sold.
- b. Segregation of articles

- c. Publicity of Sale
- d. Supervision of Sale
- e. Determining the successful bidders
- f. Notification of successful bidders
- g. Receipt of Dollars and Yen
- h. Issuance of "Certificate of Ownership" (Bill of Sale)

Eighth Army will be responsible for the following:

- a. Supply necessary operational personnel
- b. Road signs showing way to warehouses. (Supervision only, labor and material from JG)
- c. Policing of warehouses
- d. Control inspection in warehouses utilizing such safety precautions that may be necessary
- e. Bus service from nearest rail station to warehouse
- f. Provide sanitary facilities at each warehouse site. (Supervision only, labor and material from JG)
- g. Parking facilities at warehouse locations
- h. Instructing and helping prospective bidders
- i. Guard "bid" boxes
- j. Provide Armed Guard Service and transportation for bid boxes daily
- k. Custody of all items in the warehouse locations
- l. Custody of all retainables at conclusion of sale


Japanese Government will be responsible for the following:

- a. Provide all personnel required in movement, segregation, disposition, uncrating and recrating of property
- b. Furnish all materials necessary in the recrating of items to be retained.

In conclusion it is pointed out that all of the above information is subject to change or modification. However, no major deviations on the proposed plan are expected other than minor ones necessary to fit the local situation.

At present inventories are under study by the Accounts Branch, CPC, GHQ, SCAP, for the purpose of determining (a) what items of property should be sold first, (b) what items of property would have the greatest demand among the Occupation forces, and (c) arriving at a fair minimum bid figure to be placed on certain items.

Major John W. Rife, CPC, GHQ, SCAP, in charge of German property sales for the Civil Property Custodian and Major C.D. Sutherland, Finance and Civil Property Division, Eighth Army Military Government Section, will arrive in Kyoto and Osaka on or about 19 April 1948 for the purpose of discussing the sale procedure to be followed at the Eighth Army German Property Warehouse in Osaka.
