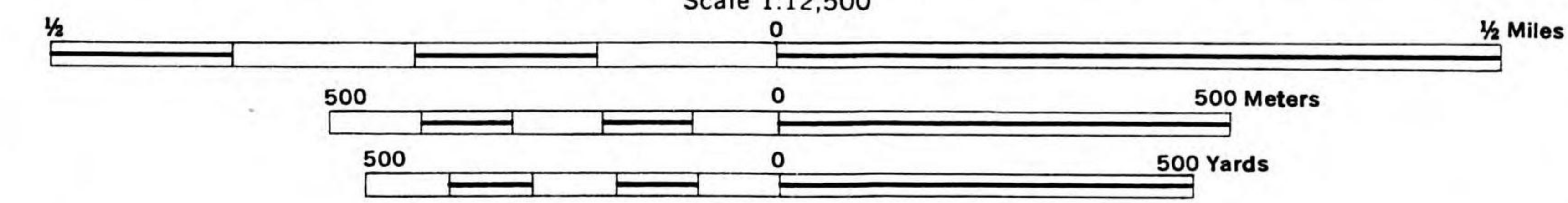


POLYCONIC PROJECTION
CONTOUR INTERVAL 10 METERS


