2. Attention is directed to paragraph 6a, AR 345-400, dated 3 January 1945, as amended by Changes No. 2 dated 13 March 1946, which reads in part as follows:

"6. Disposition of copies-a.*** Copies No. 1 will be forwarded to the machine records unit or statistical control unit on the morning following the close of the morning report day.***"

3. Delayed receipt of morning reports is a major problem in keeping staff sections of General Headquarters, Far East Command, and the War Department supplied with up-to-date personnel statistics. Statistics extracted from morning reports by machine records units are widely used by higher headquarters in planning both personnel and supply programs. Therefore, the need for accurate preparation and prompt submission of morning reports cannot be overemphasized.

4. At best, morning report lag is excessive in this area because of poor communication facilities. It is therefore incumbent upon all echelons of command to insure that these documents are promptly submitted by the most expeditious means available. In no instance will morning reports for one unit be held at any headquarters pending receipt of delayed reports from another unit.

5. A reply will be made by indorsement hereon stating the date on which morning reports listed in paragraph 1 above were forwarded. Comments regarding problems encountered in prompt submission of morning reports are invited. Reply will be addressed to Commander-in-Chief, Far East Command, Attention: Strength Accounting Branch, APO 500.

SUBJECT: Late Reports

TO : Commanding officer, Kyushu Military Government Region, Hq & Hq
Det, APO 929

1. With reference to the efficiency rating for the Fukuoka Team as shown on IB No. 5 the following information is given:

a. The Semi-Monthly Activities Report was delayed due to procedure used by the Adjutant of Region who instructed the head of the typing pool not to type this report for the team. When typing was finally completed by one team typist, the mimeograph work was held up until completion of the Region Report, after which the team work was done.

b. The MSP 30 Report was reported late by 10 days. The original request for this report did not indicate that it was to be a monthly report. OD 5/7 requested that a survey be made on plants working on P.D.'s. The survey was completed in November and no further reports were forwarded. It is understood that Region made subsequent requests for this report, but due to a change in department heads during the period, the new officer in charge was unaware of the requirements set forth. A letter has been sent forward requesting clarification of this report since it is felt that the information contained therein is of little value.
