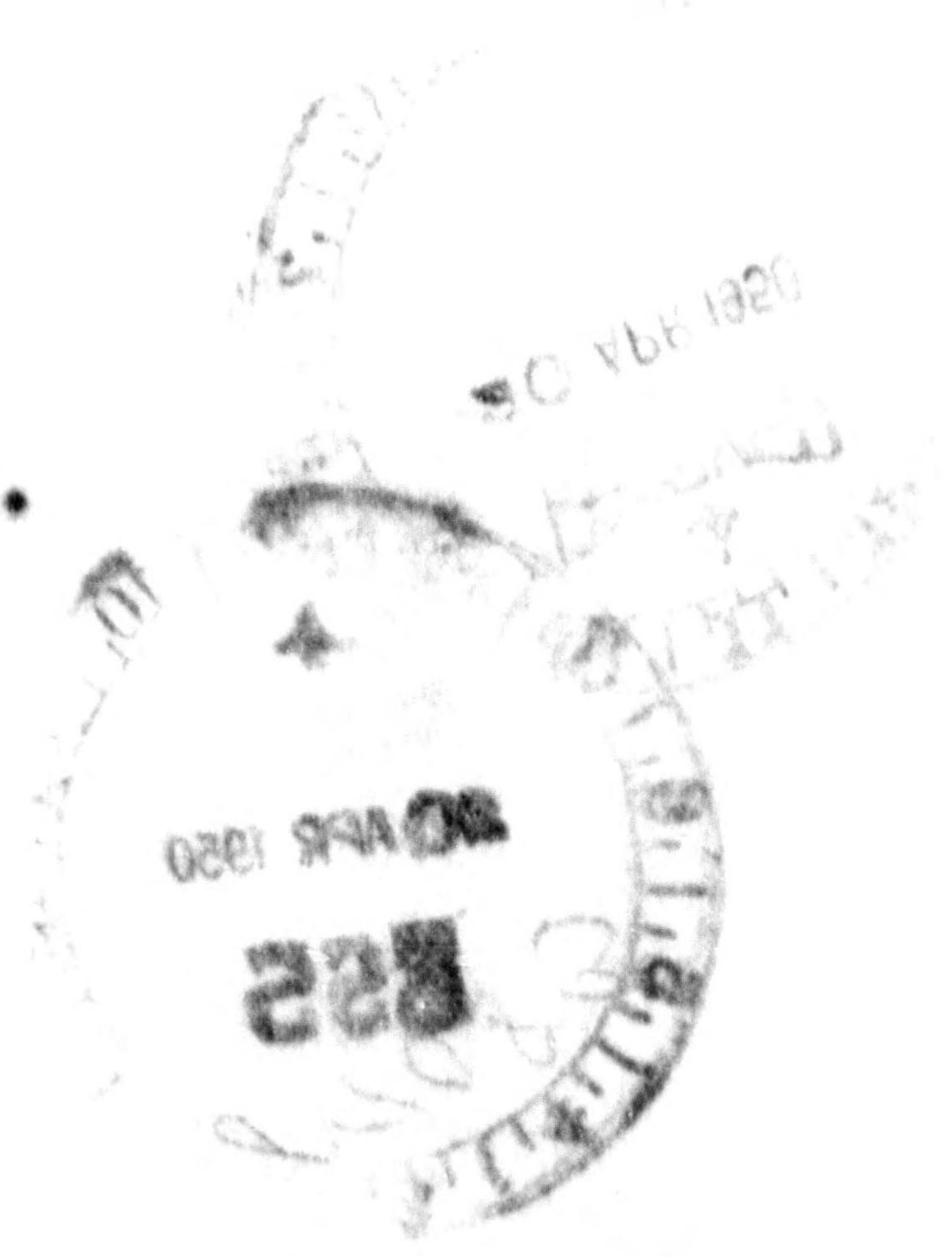

1. Reference:

a. SCAPIN-629 (20 Jan. 46) subject: "Custody, Control and Protective Maintenance of Japanese Aircraft Plants, Arsenals and Laboratories".

2. The Reparations Agency hereby submits to your Headquarters an application of the Daido Sangyo K.K. for Authorized Use of the reparations equipment of the former Maizuru Naval Arsenal (22-24), together with recommendations of the Ministries of Transportation and of Finance as inclosed herewith.

3. The subject company, which has been engaged in the construction and repair of wooden boats as well as in the maintenance work of the reparations equipment belonging to the said arsenal within the confines of the automobile repair shop of the 31st Naval Aeronautical Depot (22-26B), wishes to increase the production by utilizing thirty-five (35) reparations machines of the said Arsenal and a part of the warehouse of the said Depot. This utilization would enable the subject company to enhance its productive capacity per month from 80 to 200 gross tons in the repair, and from 8 to 30 gross tons in the construction of wooden boats.

4. As the demand for the construction and repair of wooden boats which are to be used for fishing and local transportation is considerably large now in Japan, particularly in the Maizuru district, the proposed increase of production is recognized as desirable and appropriate.

5. Such being the case, it is earnestly requested that your Headquarters be good enough to give a special consideration to the application.
