nel when new building completed. Need transportation badly, have but
3 bicycles. Not enough ^{help} to sufficiently complete requirements outlined
by H.C. law.

H. Recommendations:

The second floor of health center completely unused ; the plans for new
health center call for building three times the size of present building.
It appears that transportation and trained personnel far more needed than
new, pretentious buildings. The Health Education services appear to be
at a standstill.

There are 8 H.C. in this pref. This H.C. ranks Sub-Min.




It appears this health center is doing nothing. Dr. in charge does not seem to have plans for the future. The building is new and short of equipment, but it seems that staff is doing nothing in way of wise use of time while waiting for equipment. There are no programs set up and patients

are turned away because, Dr. Ishikawa said, there was no examining equipment. Prefecture puts him off constantly, so he said, when requesting equipment.



Size of building 52 Tsubo.


Size of land plot 110 Tsubo.
