**The Pensions Appeal Tribunals (England and Wales)
(Amendment) Rules 1972**

Made - - - 27th September 1972
Laid before Parliament 6th October 1972
Coming into Operation 1st November 1972

The Lord Chancellor, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 5(4) of the Schedule to the Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943(a) and after consultation with the Council on Tribunals in accordance with section 10 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971(b), hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (England and Wales) (Amendment) Rules 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1972.

2. The Pensions Appeal Tribunals Rules 1971(c), as amended (d), shall be further amended as follows:—

In Schedule 2 Part I (which relates to subsistence allowances to appellants, etc.) in paragraph 1(a), for the figures “£0·15”, “£0·27½” and “£0·57½” there shall be substituted the figures “£0·20”, “£0·35” and “£0·70” respectively and in paragraph 1(b), for the figures “£2·00” and “£1·80” there shall be substituted the figures “£2·70” and “£2·40” respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (England and Wales) Rules 1971 by increasing the maximum allowance payable under paragraph (1) of Rule 27 of those Rules to an appellant or other person absent from home for the purpose of attending the Tribunal or undergoing a medical examination.
