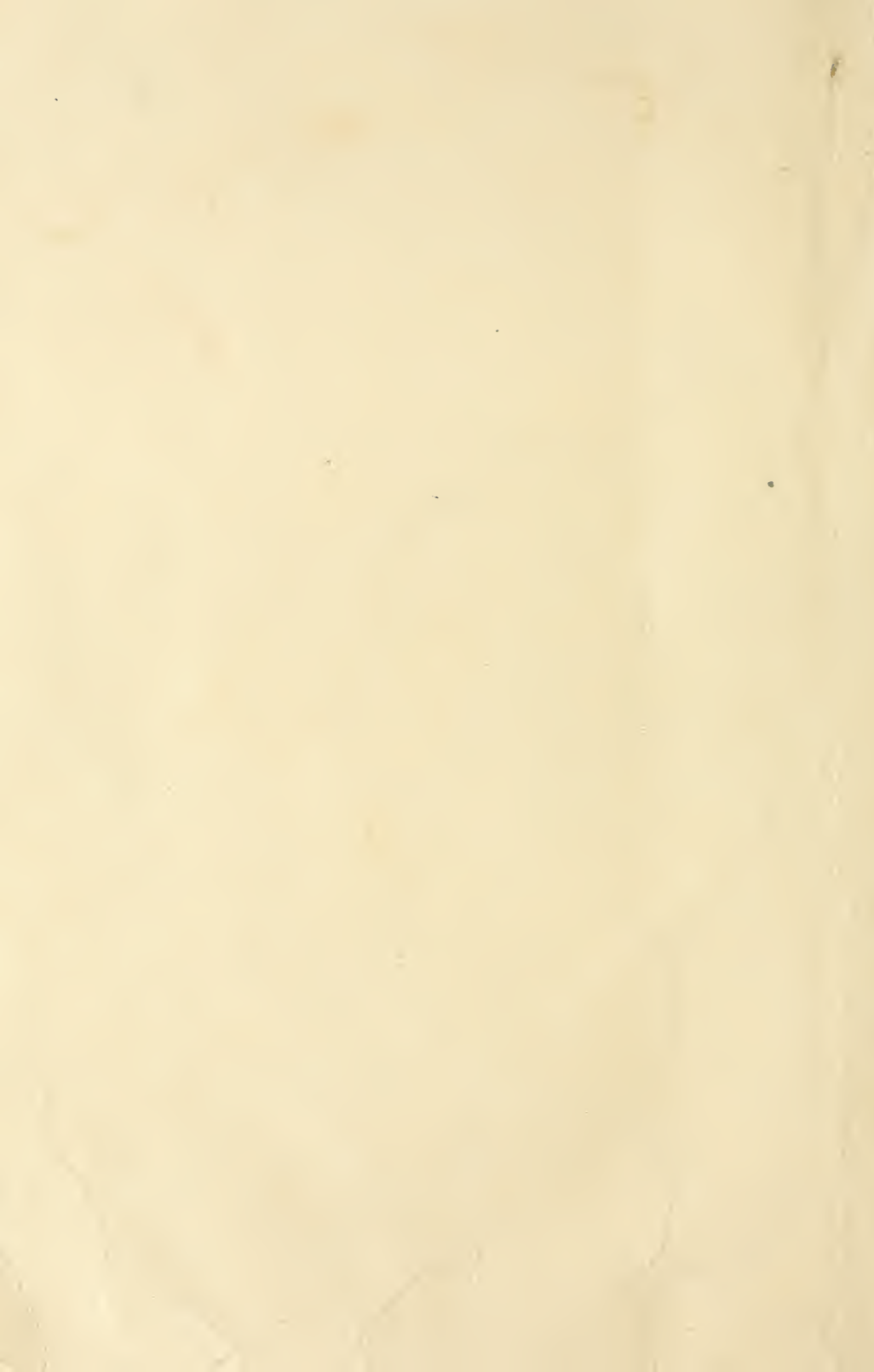

In presenting this price list of Palms and Dracaenas I would most respectfully thank those who have so long favored me with their patronage, and assure them and those who may become my patrons, that I shall aim by fair dealing to receive a continuance of the same.

My stock is very large and in a fine condition.

All plants will be turned out of pots and sent per express unless otherwise ordered. During spring, summer and autumn many plants can be sent by freight, especially large plants, to points reached by the B. & M., M. P. and U. P. Railroads. All plants will be carefully packed (no charges for packing and boxing) and delivered at express or freight office at Plattsmouth, Neb., in good condition, after which my responsibility ceases.

Remittances may be made by postoffice order, express order, draft or registered letter. All claims for mistakes or errors must be made within five days after plants are received.

All orders must be accompanied by the cash or satisfactory references, unless from parties of known responsibility to me. You may be perfectly responsible, but I must know it before sending plants.

All bills subject to sight draft if not paid in thirty days from date of invoice unless otherwise agreed before shipment of goods.

Purchasers should be particular to give names in full, with express and postoffice address, county and state, distinctly written, so that no mistakes will occur.

TILLANDSIA BRACTEATA. One of the largest Wind Pines or Air Plants. Full-grown plants are 1 to 2 feet in diameter and height, spikes often 18 inches or more in length; the large brilliant, crimson bracts and flower-stalks and purple blossoms are very showy, and remain beautiful for weeks. A most valuable plant for conservatory or bay window, enduring a low temperature (though but little frost), requiring no care except an occasional spraying. Attach to wood, or hang in a small wire basket. No. 1, 2 cents; No. 3, 5 cents; No. 4, 10 cents; No. 5, 15 cents; No. 6, 20 cents; No. 7, 25 cents; very large, 50 cents.

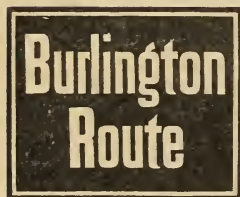
