

Costa Rica - Volcanic Activity

- Turrialba volcano, located approx. 35 km east of the Costa Rica capital San José, erupted on 30 October, spewing ash that reached the capital.
- According to media (as of early 31 October), the Costa Rica authorities declared a Yellow Alert, ordered the closure of the national park around the volcano and nearby residents were evacuated to temporary shelters. As of early 31 October, there were no reports of injuries or damage.

INDIA, PAKISTAN Tropical cyclone NIOLOFAR

- NIOLOFAR moved north-east over the Arabian Sea, weakening into a Low Pressure Area off the coast of Gujarat State (India) and Sindh (Pakistan) on 31 October. In the next 24 h locally heavy rains and winds may affect parts of Gujarat and Sindh.
