h. Prisoners of War.

a. As soon as possible after any persons are captured or taken into custody by United Nations Command forces, including ROKA forces commanded by CG, Eighth Army, such persons will be screened to determine whether they are prisoners of war as defined in Article 4 of the "Geneva Prisoner of War Convention Relative to the Treatment of Prisoners of War of August 12, 1949" (hereinafter referred to as the "Geneva Prisoner of War Convention"). Pending such determination, all persons taken into custody will be treated in accordance with the humanitarian principles of the Geneva Prisoner of War Convention but will not be reported or processed as prisoners of war.

b. Prisoners of War will be treated at all times in accordance with the provisions of the Geneva Prisoner of War Convention by all United Nations Command forces, including ROKA forces commanded by CG, Eighth Army. The provisions of Chapter IV, FM 27-10, "Rules of Land Warfare" will be followed so far as they do not conflict with the Geneva Prisoner of War Convention.

c. Persons captured by or otherwise falling into the hands of the United Nations Command forces, who qualify within the definitions of prisoners of war but who are suspected of having committed war crimes, will be considered and treated nevertheless as prisoners of war until such time as they have been convicted by a military tribunal of crime against the laws and customs of war or have been released by proper authority.

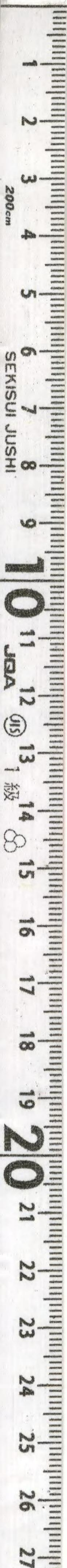
d. ROKA forces or United Nations forces other than US forces will deliver to US forces prisoners of war captured by them or falling into

their hands, at the earliest possible date. Prisoner of war camps, except such transit camps as may be required at collecting points, will be established only by US forces. Processing of prisoners of war, excluding intelligence procedures, will be handled upon arrival at prisoner of war camps operated by US forces.

e. COMNAVFE and CG, FFAF will turn over prisoners of war captured by any UN forces under their command, as soon as practicable, to the nearest US Army forces.

f. CG, Eighth Army will be responsible for the processing of prisoners of war and for the operation of all prisoner of war camps. Prisoner of war camps will be operated by US Army troops but the use of ROKA guards under the supervision of US Army troops is authorized.

g. In determining whether persons captured or taken into custody by United Nations Command forces including ROKA forces commanded by CG, Eighth Army should be classified as prisoners of war, category (6) Article 4 of the Geneva Prisoner of War Convention is applicable north of the 38th parallel but is not applicable south of the 38th parallel.

1. This office possesses no pertinent information contradictory to that presented in paragraph 2 of the basic letter sent from CG, EUSAK to CINCPAC. EUSAK and the Corps concerned are in possession of more detailed information pertaining to the zone of these operations than is this office. Both operations are limited objective attacks and employ relatively small numbers of troops. There are no indications that these operations will result in enemy large-scale counteraction.

2. The area chosen for operation CHOPSTICK 16 is the most lightly held portion of the enemy front. The area selected for CHOPSTICK 6 is probably the second most lightly held sector.

3. In view of the trafficability requirements of CHOPSTICK 6 and the flood conditions desired for CHOPSTICK 16, it is considered particularly important that the operations be executed on order of the field commanders.

4. The inclosed overlay shows that portion of the enemy's 1st and 2nd defense lines known to be in the zone of CHOPSTICK 6. Information shown on the overlay was obtained from a captured document.

This is an amplifying report:

At 181900 I friendly forces on Island DU 173012 were attacked by undetermined number of enemy ships supported by shore fire from hill DU 173010. Kirkland requested assistance. Hamner arrived from bomblines shortly after dark after friendly forces had evacuated. Friendly forces captured 1, sank 1 and probably sank 2 more Flvs. Because of unfamiliarity with local situation Hamner requested Higbees assistance from CTE 77.15. Friendly forces embarked under cover of Hamner fire and were escorted safely back to Nando. Fired 9 rounds on Island DU 173012 and 59 rounds on hill 163010. Latter observed by SFCP as "on target". Higbee released and returned to CTE 77.15. Island now classified possibly enemy occupied. All enemy sampans either sunk or returned to beach.

1. For G-3. In view of the relative static situation along the front at the present time, the majority of Part II B of the CINCFE Daily Sitrep contains daily repetitions of locations of all units although there may not have been anything of significance to report for all such units.

2. It is believed that the above method of reporting, which provides a complete and independent picture of all units each day, can be simplified by limiting the complete report to a weekly basis and substituting on the other days of the week reports which cover only those units in whose areas something of significance has occurred.
