






Past

How we got to the Wikimedia Cloud Services we have today



Ancient times: 2001-2010



- 2001 Wikipedia started
- 2001 Bots started doing things
- [...]
- 2005 Toolserver created by WMDE
- [...]



Past: 2011 - 2014

- 2011 Wikimedia Labs project started
- 2012 Wikimedia Labs has 120+ projects and 600+ users
- 2013 "Tool Labs" project started with intent to replace Toolserver
- 2014 Quarry introduced
- 2014 Toolserver was shutdown



Past: 2015 - 2017

- 2015 PAWS introduced
- 2015 Initial kubernetes support
- 2015 “Labs labs labs” naming problem
- 2017 Wikimedia Cloud Services team created
- 2017 Labs and Tool Labs rebranded as Cloud VPS and Toolforge
- 2017 Wiki-Replicas redesigned



Past: 2018 - 2020

- 2018 Openstack Neutron network deployed
- 2019 HTTPS enforced for Toolforge
- 2019 Ubuntu replaced with Debian in Toolforge
- 2020 Toolforge Kubernetes cluster rebuilt
- 2020 New toolforge.org domain introduced
- 2020 Wiki-Replicas redesigned


Some numbers

- ~30.5% of total wiki edits come from WMCS [\[April 2023\]](#)
- ~ 3200 Toolforge tools
- ~ 2500 Toolforge maintainers
- ~ 1000 Cloud VPS virtual machines
- ~ 200 Cloud VPS projects
- 4000 vCPU, 27 TB memory, 140 TB storage






Toolforge

- Analytics / Data lake ?






