
#### International Mother Language Day







#### What "Language" means to us?


- Not only just a medium to communicate

- Language is a part of our emotional values












#### Early Struggles of Indic Languages

- Making Awareness and motivate people to use the technology available




#### Early Struggles of Bangla Language In Digital World


