### SITUATION

- Severe weather, including snow storms, strong winds and extreme low temperature, are affecting the south-eastern Europe, especially Italy, Greece and the Balkans. As of 9 January, several Meteoalarm – Red and Orange Alerts are still in effect in Europe (see map).
- According to local media, as of 9 January at 7.00 UTC, at least eight people have been killed in Italy due to extreme low temperatures.
- Extreme cold weather is to prevail over the Balkans and, in a lesser degree, over central and northern Italy for the next three days with very low minimum temperatures. Local snowfalls are forecast with extreme low temperatures. Weather conditions are forecast to improve temporarily from Wednesday (for local snowfalls) and from Friday (for minimum temperatures) onwards.
