PREFACE

This selected list of research publications in the field of agricultural economics and related socio-economic studies covers a period of approximately one year ending September 30, 1966. The list is intended to include citations for all published material of more than temporary interest regardless of the form in which published or the current availability.

Important among these are publications in U. S. Department of Agriculture and Economic Research Service series, periodic reports and articles in periodicals of the Department, and State Experiment Station bulletins which report results of Federal-State cooperative studies in agricultural economics. Articles in technical and professional journals, both within and outside the Department, are cited. Proceedings of symposia and conferences are included when they contain papers which report important ERS research results.

Papers, speeches, articles in nontechnical journals and other news, informational, or extension items generally have been excluded as not being of continuing importance. A few of such reports have been included if, at the time of release, they presented significant initial research results or findings not available elsewhere. The elements included for each citation and their arrangements are planned to meet usual library indexing requirements.

In this list, publications are grouped by subject matter areas and by ERS divisions responsible for research in such areas. The special sequential bibliographical card technique which was used provides a permanent deck of cards that will be available for future uses. Cards can be punched for classification and sorting into any desired categories. Special publication lists for specific problem areas can thus be prepared quickly and at minimum cost. Additions and deletions to the deck can be handled readily thereby facilitating the maintenance of current publication lists.

Citation of publications in this list does not mean that copies are available. Generally, reference copies can be found in libraries. Publications from State Experiment Stations can usually be obtained from issuing institutions. Some items produced by nonpublic agencies are available from the publishers. Unpublished materials such as dissertations are included for the information of research workers in related problem areas. They can be obtained only from authors or institutions where the research was conducted. Such items are preceded by the designation \*\*. Most ERS and Department publications can be obtained from the Division of Information, Office of Management Services; or photocopy reproductions of any of these citations in the library collection may be purchased from the National Agricultural Library, Photo Copy Section, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C. 20250.
