For this reason and because of its high cost we cannot entertain claims of non-germination of this seed. If handled with due care, we know it will grow. Cultural hints (supplied free with each order) if consistently followed, will, we believe, insure good germination of all Petunia varieties listed in this book.

WHEN PLANTING SMALL SEEDS If small seeds such as those of Petunias, are mixed with finely sifted soil, better results are obtained than by broadcasting the seed and covering with soil. The soil should be well firmed, then covered with burlap, and watered with a fine spray. It is necessary to spray once or twice a day to keep the ground damp. In a short time the seeds sprout. As soon as they come through the soil the burlap should be removed.

New Fancy Petunia—Ruffled Nana Compacta, "Martha Washington"

A new break in Petunias. Martha Washington is a ruffled or frilled nana compacta. Its growth is about 9 inches high and it forms a perfect ball effect, literally smothered with lovely frilled blooms about 3 inches in diameter. Its neat, compact habit has never before been seen in Petunias.

The color is quite remarkable.
