

Express Letters, 10 cents per article in addition to ordinary postage.

Newspapers, per 50 grammes, ½ cent (limit, 2 kilogm.). Mongolia, 1½ cts.

Books, Printed Matter, and Commercial Papers, 100 gm., 1 cent; 100 to 250 gm., 2½ cents; 250 to 500 gm., 5 cents; 500 to 1,000 gm., 7½ cents; 1,000 gm. to 2 kilos, (limit), 15 cents. To Mongolia, per 250 gm. 30 cts.

Samples, up to 100 gm., 2 cents; 100 to 250 gm., 5 cents; 250 to 350 gm., (limit), 10 cents. Parcels (limited to 10 kilos, and 3½ feet by 3½ by 3½): 1 kilo, 20 cents; each added kilo, up to ten, at 10 cts. (Non-steam-served places take various rates, too numerous to quote on this page.)

Union Countries: Letters, per 20 grammes, 10 cents; each added 20 grammes, 5 cents. Registration with return receipt, 20 cents; registration, 10 cents. Post Cards, 6 cents; reply cards, 12 cents.

PARCELS: Parcels may be insured up to \$500.00 at and for a limited number of offices against a domestic insurance fee of ½ per cent of the amount with a minimum fee of 5 cents; the fee for Szechwan is, however, 2% and the limit \$50.00 with a minimum fee of 10 cents on each parcel, except for down river parcels posted at Chungking or Wanhsien, for which the limit is \$500. Domestic parcels are charged at single, double, treble, quintuple or sextuple rates, according to the routes followed. A return receipt may be obtained on payment of an additional fee of 5 cents in the case of domestic parcels.

Parcels taxed with trade charges—limited to \$500—are accepted for transmission between Parcel Insurance Offices on payment of a 2 per cent fee of the amount to be collected.

Money Orders, variable, may be ascertained at the issuing Office. Minimum charge, 5 cents per order. Limit of one Order, \$200 between Money Order Offices Aa., and \$100 between offices A, or A and Aa; \$50 between Offices B, or B, and A, or Aa. For list of places to which Orders are issuable, see Postal Guide, Part II.

CURRENCY (for the purchase of Stamps).—Full value dollars purchase 100 cents in stamps; inferior dollars and fractional coins only accepted at current discount. Copper cash accepted at average dollar exchange rates periodically fixed by the Postal Commissioner.






