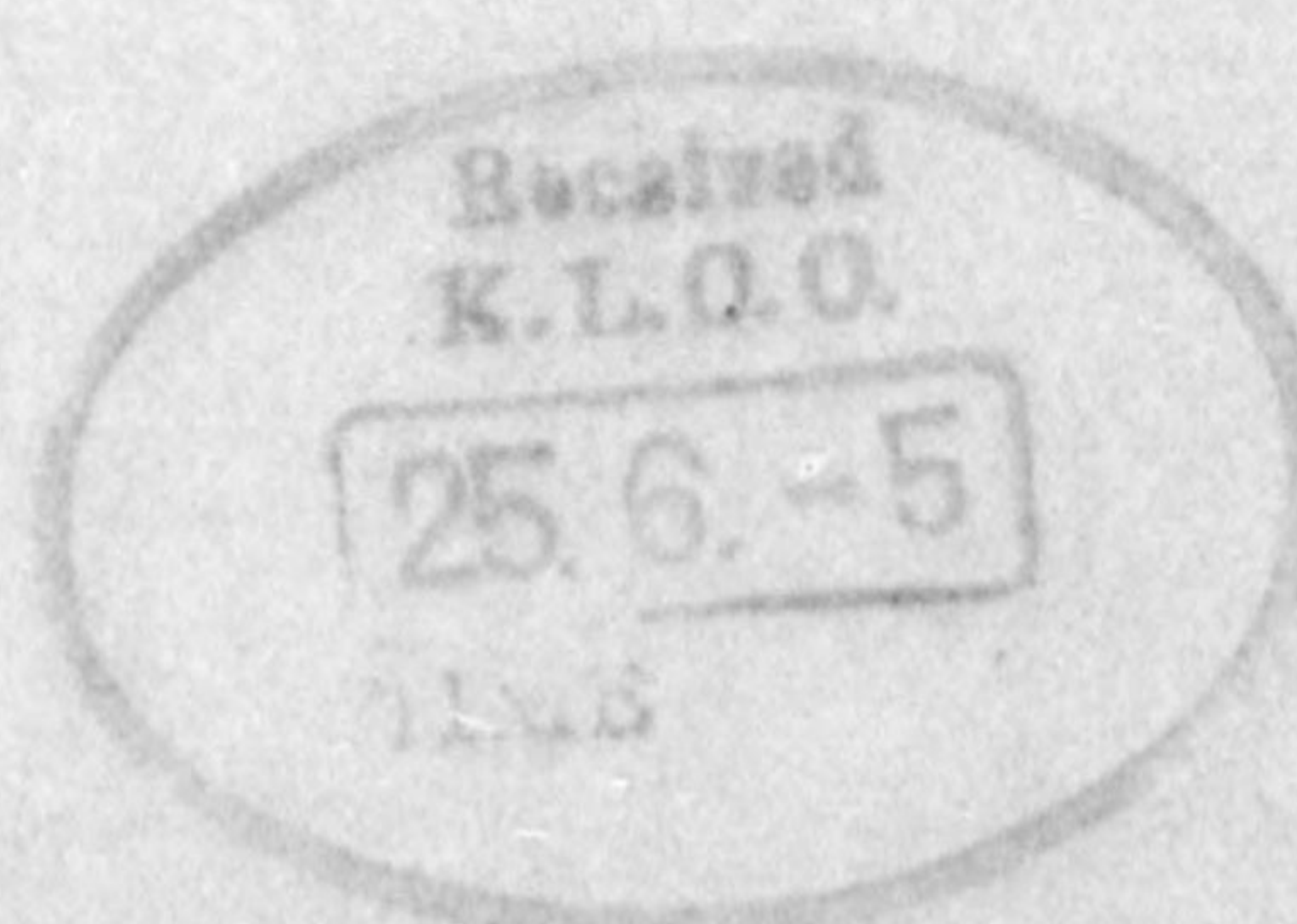

May Report on Agricultural Improvement Activities

Some teams for the program will make investigation by using special light for getting prior knowledge of leaf hoppers.

(11) Preparation of agricultural map.

Climatic environ, locating map for unsuitable farms and locating map for acid soil will be included in the map.

(12) Examination related to inadequate crop of paddy rice in fall.

Preparatory examination related to wind erosion will be carried out at Kuroiso Experiment Station.

3. Principal agricultural improvement program.

(1) Abolition and/or revision of bylaws and principles.

(3) Periodical liaison and coordination conference for agricultural farm advisors.

The liaison and coordination conference was set up in each gun-district totaling nine in the prefecture. Following are the leading subjects discussed and decisions passed.

A. Guidance program for June.

(a) Seed raising including rice, wheat and barley and so forth. Supervision on seed planting in Summer time.

(b) Livestock including sanitation for summer time and others.

(c) Guidance on the supervision of the seed breeding farm.

B. Execution program for 1950.

C. Healthy Seedlings Raising Exhibition.

D. Others.

(4) Holding of the healthy seedlings raising exhibition.

Sponsorship will be taken by the prefecture relating to rice seedling beds, sweet potatoes

seedling bed (in spring time) and rape seedling bed (in autumn).

Exhibition shipment of rice will be made on the unit of individual or group (such as village block or research club), same shipment of sweet potatoes on the unit of group, while rape seeds on the unit of gun-district. Judgement will be made by gun-district and at the level of the prefecture.

Judgement by gun-district has been under way in the latter part of May 1950, while judgement of paddy rice has been started in the latter part of May 1950.

Number of items exhibited.

Paddy rice: 535 from individual and 122 from groups.

Sweet potatoes: 79 from groups.

For the facilitation of the activities of the local agricultural advisors, total number of 134 bicycles painted in green was purchased and lent them to each advisor.

3. Condition of crops.

- (1) Wheat and barley.

In the early period of growing, we worried about unsatisfactory crops this year but along with recovery of weather and the effective guidance of the authorities as well as the practical demonstration of farmers the crop condition has gradually been restored. However, we have not yet come to optimistic stage for the crops because of the current outgrowth of red mould disease, white powder-like disease of leaves, inadequate ripening of the Golden Melon which is a kind of barley and bending or fell-down situation of plants which were caused by the storm on 20 May 1950.

- (2) Vegetables.

There is adequate growing of every type of vegetables.

- (3) Rape seeds.

Except some parts of inadequate growing, the blooming and seed bearing condition is good in general.

- (4) Hemp.

Seeds were planted in adequate season and the growing situation is satisfactory.

(5) White potatoes.

Seed planting was made at proper time in every area. Corn growing condition and raising situation are generally in good condition.

4. Crops harvested with average yields.

It is expected that wheat and barley crops would come near to the average yields under the above mentioned situation.

5. Area under reclamation and pertinent data thereto.

(A) Area under actual reclamation at the present time:
32 cho (area reclaimed during April).

(B) Total area converted into farm land by the post-war reclamation program: 8,728 cho (as of the end of April).
