Prime Minister's Office Ordinance No. 21

In Par. 1 of Art. 2, "or the Industrial Reconstruction Corporation" shall be added next to "the mining rights holders concerned." Supplementary Provision:

#### MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

#### Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 35

The Regulations concerning the Lending of Machinery for Reclamation shall be enacted as follows:

Regulations concerning the Lending of Machinery for Reclamation

Article 1. The lending of machinery for reclamation in accordance with Art. 2, Item 6 of the Law concerning Gratuitous Lending and Transfer, etc. of State Goods, Law No. 229 of 1947 shall be effected in compliance with the provisions of the present Ordinance.

Article 2. The Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may, for the purpose of promoting land development work, lend machines for reclamation to Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido and other prefectures, cities, towns, villages, and such agricultural cooperative associations, federations of agricultural cooperative associations, the Japan Land Development Society, prefectural land development Societies, and organizations formed by settlers as carrying on land development work, and other reclamation enterprises.

Article 3. A person who intends to borrow a machine for reclamation shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a written application for borrowing (in quadruplicate) in Annexed Form No. 1 together with a written plan for the work (in duplicate) in Annexed Form No. 2.

Article 4. If, in case where the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry has received the written application for borrowing as mentioned in the preceding Article, he deems it proper upon examination, he shall give permission for lending it and notify the applicant thereof by a notice of lending.

Article 5. The term of lending a machine for reclamation shall be determined by the Min:

ister of Agriculture and Forestry within the limits of one year; provided that the said Minister may on application by the borrower renew such term.

The term of lending mentioned in the preceding paragraph shall be computed by the month and as from the day of delivery stated in the notice of lending mentiond in the preceding Article and mature on the day in the last month preceding the day corresponding to that from which computation is made; but if there is no corresponding day in the last month, the last day of the month shall be the day of maturity.

If the borrower, in accordance with the proviso of Par. 1, intends to make an application for the renewal of the term of borrowing, he shall not later than one month before the day of maturity, submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a written application for the renewal of borrowing (in quadruplicate) in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 with the necessary modifications.

- Article 6. The lending of a machine for reclamation shall be made in consideration of rent, which is to be prescribed separately; but the lending may be made free of charge in the following
  - 1. If such lending is made for the purpose of education, experiment or diffusion or propagation of national policy or under taking;

2. If it is deemed improper to make such lending for a consideration.

In case a revision has been made of the rate of rent, the rent for the month following that in which the revision was made and thereafter shall be paid according to the revised rate.

Article 7. In respect of the period during which the machine borrowed cannot be used for a cause for which the borrower cannot be held responsible, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may exempt the borrower from the payment of the rent.

In the case mentioned in the preceding paragraph, the borrower shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a written application for the extension of the term of lending (in quadruplicate) in Annexed Form No. 3, stating the cause in detail.

If the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, considering the cause mentioned in the preceding paragraph as truly unavoidable, has permitted the exemption of the rent and the extension of the term of use, such part of the term as so extended shall not be included in the term of lending decided in accordance with the provisions of Art. 5.

Article 8. The rent of a machine for reclamation shall be paid in advance, according to the notice of payment issued every six months by the

revenue collecting official of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.

Article 9. The borrower shall, if he does not return the machine borrowed by the date appointed by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry in accordance with the provisions of Art. 12, pay such damages for breach of contract as corresponding to twice the amount of rent for the day following the foregoing date and thereafter, except in cases where the returning cannot be effected for an unavoidable cause.

If the period during which the returning mentioned in the preceding paragraph is delayed is less than one month, such period shall be deemed to be one month.

The provisions of Art. 8 shall apply with the necessary modifications to the collection o damages for breach of contract provided in Par. 1.

Article 10. After the payment of the rent of the machine for reclamation, the borrower may not demand the refundment of such rent except in cases where the said machine could not be used for a cause for which he cannot be held responsible.

Article 11. The conditions of lending of a machine for reclamation shall be as follows:

1. All the expenses for taking delivery of and returning such machine shall be borne by the borrower;

2. If the machine borrowed has been lost or damaged, the borrower shall without delay submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a detailed report on the cause of such loss or damage together with a certificate by the authorities concerned in order to have the instructions issued by the said Minister;

3. The machine borrowed shall not be subleased.

Article 12. The delivery of a machine for reclamation which has been decided to be lent shall be made on such day and at such place as designated by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry.

When the borrower has received the borrowed machine in accordance with the preceding paragraph, he shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a receipt in Annexed Form No. 4.

In case the borrower has been delivered the borrowed machine from the former borrower in accordance with the instructions by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, he shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a paper proving succession to the lease together with the said receipt.

When the borrower intends to return the machine borrowed, he shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a notice

of return in Annexed Form No. 6.

If, in case the borrower returns the machine borrowed, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry has given notice to him with designation of the receiver, the borrower shall prepare a paper proving succession to the lease and hand it to the said receiver.

Article 13. The borrower shall keep the machine borrowed with the care of a good manager.

Article 14. If the borrower has lost or damaged the machine borrowed, he shall make compensation for the loss in kind or repair the damaged machine, bearing the necessary expenses for such compensation or repairing.

If it is impossible from the nature of the loss or damage mentioned in the preceding paragraph to make compensation for it in kind or repair it, the Minister of Agriculture or Forestry shall collect the compensation money from the borrower; but this shall not apply in cases where such loss or damage is due to a cause for which the borrower cannot be held responsible.

The provisions of Art. 8 shall apply with the necessary modifications to the collection of compensation money prescribed by the preceding paragraph.

Article 15. The borrower must use the machine borrowed in the area designated by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry.

If the borrower intends to make, within the same prefecture, an addition to or a change in the area in which the machine borrowed is to be used, he shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a written application (in duplicate)in accordance with the provisions of Art. 3 with the necessary modifications, stating the reason therefor.

If the borrower, immediately after having used the machine borrowed in one prefecture, intends to use it also in another prefecture, he shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry a notice of return stating the reason for such use and also an applicaion for borrowing in accordance with the provisions of Art. 3 anew.

In case where the return mentioned in the preceding paragraph is made before the expiration of the term of lending, the rent for the period from the day of the return to the expiration of the term of lending shall be appropriated to the rent for lending in the new area.

Article 16. The borrower shall every month submit a copy of the monthly report of the results of use in Annexed Form No. 7 ot the governor of Tokyo Metropolies, Hokkaido or other prefecture concerned and two copies thereof to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry not later than the tenth day of the following month.

Article 17. If the borrower falls under any of the

following items, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may order him to return the machine borrowed, and cause him to return it to the place designated and also to bear the expenses necessary therefor:

1. If he makes a false entry in any of the written applications, receipts or reports prescribed in this Ordinance;

2. If he neglects to submit any of the receipts or reports prescribed in this Ordinance;

3. If he contravenes any of the conditions of lending as specified in Art. 11;

4. If he fails to pay the rent by the date prescribed in this Ordinance;

5. If he so acts as to be found unqualified for the borrower.

Article 18. In case the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry has received any of the written applications mentioned in Art. 4, Art. 5, Par. 3, Art. 7, Par. 2 and Art. 15, Par. 2, he shall give notice to the applicant as to whether permission has been given or not for such application.

Article 19. The papers to be submitted by the borrower to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry in accordance with this Ordinance shall be submitted to the governor of Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido or other prefecture exercising jurisdiction over the area concerned, and thereupon the said governor shall send them together with his subreport to the said Minister directly in the case of the governor of Hokkaido, and through the chief of the local office of the Agricultural Machinery Controlling Office in the case of the governor of Tokyo Metropolis or any other prefecture.

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Ordinance shall apply as from April 1, 1947.

The machines lent on or before March 31, 1948 in accordance with the Regulations for the Lending of Large-typed Agricultural Machinery and Implements for Land Development (Notification of the Director of the Land Development Bureau of May 31, 1946) or the Directions for the Lending of Machinery and Implements for Reclamamation (Notification of the Governor of Hokkaido of August 6, 1946) shall be deemed to have been lent in accordance with the present Ordinance; provided that the rent for the period not later than March 31, 1948 shall not be collected.
