THIS FOUR PLANE BARGE SWEEP WAS BRIEFED TO RELEASE THE NAPALM TANKS OVER CULTIVATED AREAS IN THE YAMATO DISTRICT OF BABELTHUAP. WHILE OF NO STRATEGIC IMPORTANCE, THIS SETTLEMENT DOES CONTAIN A MISCELLANEOUS ASSORTMENT OF BUILDINGS, A BRIDGE, GARDENS, AND A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF ENEMY PERSONNEL. IT HAS BEEN THE SUBJECT OF A SYSTEMATIC BOMBING PROGRAM FOR THE PAST WEEK--FEW SUITABLE TARGETS REMAIN INTACT.

GOOD COVERAGE WAS OBTAINED WITH THE NAPALM ON THIS DATE, A SIZE-ABLE AREA OF CULTIVATED LAND BEING BURNED OFF.

FOLLOWING THE RELEASE OF THE NAPALM A ROUTINE BARGE SWEEP OF THE NORTHERN PALAUS WAS CONDUCTED WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.
