## RESOLUTIONS

*Passed at the Quarterly Meeting of the Church Society of the Diocese of Huron, held in London December 8th, 1859. Sanctioned and approved by the Bishop of the Diocese.*

Moved by the Rev. G. J. R. Salter, M.A., seconded by Rev. F. W. Sandys, D.D.:

Whereas it frequently happens that persons from various parts of the Diocese, and from other Dioceses, make application for assistance in building Churches, Parsonages, &c., to the Clergy and Laity of the Church throughout the Diocese, without any recognised authority and proof of the facts of the case for which application is made:—“Resolved, therefore, that the Bishop be respectfully requested to establish as a rule in the Diocese that no Clergyman or Layman be permitted to collect money for any Church purpose beyond the bounds of his own Mission, or to proceed to any other Diocese for the same purpose, without the sanction and approval of the Bishop, given as a heading to his Subscription List; and that it be the duty of such Collector to communicate with each Clergyman before he makes a Collection in his Parish; and that on his return from his collection tour, every person collecting shall present his Subscription List to the Bishop, and account for all moneys received. And further, that no person from any other Diocese shall make collections within this Diocese, without first obtaining the sanction of its Bishop, under his hand and seal.

Moved by the Rev. G. J. R. Salter, M. A., seconded by Rev. E. L. Elwood, A.M.:

Resolved, that the Secretary be directed to have the foregoing resolution printed, and to forward one copy to each Clergyman in this Diocese, and to the Secretary of each Church Society in the various Dioceses of British North America.

Moved by the Rev. F. W. Sandys, D.D., seconded by the Rev. G. J. R. Salter, M.A.:

“Resolved, That inasmuch as great inconvenience and loss arise from the delay that too often takes place in making the collections for the Church Society and transmitting them to the Secretary, the Clergy are therefore requested to make the Collections on some Sunday during the month appointed for each Collection, and to see that they are forwarded without delay to the Secretary.”



# CONSTITUTION

OF THE

## Church Society of the Diocese of Huron.

---

ADOPTED BY THE SOCIETY AND CONFIRMED BY THE BISHOP, SEPTEMBER  
22ND, 1858.

### INCORPORATED FOR PROMOTING THE FOLLOWING OBJECTS :

- FIRST**—For the encouragement and support of Missionaries and Clergymen of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Diocese of Huron, and for creating a fund towards the augmentation of the stipends of poor Clergymen, and towards making provision for those who may be incapacitated by age or infirmity, and for the Widows and Orphans of the Clergy of the said Church in the said Diocese.
- SECONDLY**—For the encouragement of Education, and for the support of Day Schools and Sunday Schools in the said Diocese, in conformity with the principles of the said Church.
- THIRDLY**—For granting assistance, where it may be necessary, to those who may be preparing for the Ministry of the Gospel in the said Church, within the said Diocese.
- FOURTHLY**—For circulating in the said Diocese the Holy Scriptures, the Book of Common Prayer of the said Church, and such other Books and Tracts as shall be approved by the Central Board or Managing Committee of the said Association.
- FIFTHLY**—For obtaining and granting aid towards the erection, endowment, and maintenance of Churches, according to the establishment of the said Church, in the said Diocese; the erection and maintenance of Parsonage-houses; the setting apart of Burial-grounds, and Church-yards; the endowment and support of Parsonages and Rectories, according to the same establishment, and the management of all matters relating to such endowment.

#### I.

That before the Society shall enter upon any business at any of its meetings, the following prayers shall be said :—

Prevent us, O Lord, in all our doings, with Thy most gracious favour, and further us with Thy continual help ; that in all our works, begun, continued, and ended in Thee, we may glorify Thy Holy name, and finally by Thy mercy obtain everlasting life, through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

O God, from whom all holy desires, all good counsels, and all works of piety and charity do proceed, we beseech Thee to visit with Thy favour our Sovereign Queen Victoria, and so rule her heart, that she may in all things seek Thy honour and glory. Prosper with Thy blessing the designs of this Society. Comfort with Thy grace those benefactors who contribute to its support. Bless the ministry of Thy servants, the Clergy ; the endeavours of all who are engaged in spreading the knowledge of true religion in this Province, and the labours of those Missionaries who are promoting the same in foreign parts. And may Thy Holy Spirit direct all our consultations to the advancement of Thy glory, and the good of Thy Church, through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

“O MERCIFUL God, who has made all men, and hatest nothing that Thou hast made, nor wouldst the death of a sinner, but rather that he should be converted and live : have mercy upon all Jews, Turks, Infidels and Heretics, and also upon all those heathen nations upon which the light of Thy glorious Gospel hath not yet shone ; especially the Indians of this continent. Bless the means used for their civilization and conversion, and take from them all ignorance, hardness of heart, and contempt of Thy Word : and so fetch them home, blessed Lord, to thy flock, that they may be saved among the remnant of the true Israelites, and be made one fold under one Shepherd, Jesus Christ our Lord, who liveth and reigneth with Thee and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*”

“OUR FATHER, which art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive them that trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation ; but deliver us from evil ; for Thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. *Amen.*”

#### AND WHEN BUSINESS IS ENDED.

“ALMIGHTY God, Father of all mercies, we thine unworthy servants do give Thee most humble and hearty thanks for all Thy goodness and loving-kindness, to us and to all men : more particularly for the providential support by which this society hath been enabled to spread abroad the knowledge of Thy sacred truth. But above all, for Thy inestimable love in the redemption of the world by Thy blessed Son ; for the means of grace and for the hope of glory, which thou hast given us, in the same our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ : to whom with Thee and the Holy Ghost be all honour and glory, world without end. *Amen.*”

“The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Ghost, be with us all evermore. *Amen.*”

#### II.

That the Society shall consist of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, and of all Clergymen and Laymen who shall contribute to its funds.

#### III.

That the Lord Bishop of the Diocese be President and the Dignitaries within the Diocese be Vice-Presidents of the Society.

#### IV.

That the Corporation shall consist of the Bishop of the Diocese, of the members appointed by the charter, and of so many of the other members

as shall be elected members of the Corporation at the meetings to be from time to time holden, on the day and at the place appointed by the by-laws of the Corporation for its stated meetings.

## V.

That every incorporated member of the Society shall subscribe not less than five dollars annually, to the funds of the Society, or contribute not less than fifty dollars in one sum, or land to the value of one hundred dollars ; and it shall be the duty of the Secretary on the first day of April in each year, to notify all incorporated members who have not paid for the current year, and at the meeting in the month of June in each and every year, to make a return of those who have not paid up the five dollars for the year ending the 31st day of May previous, and such defaulters shall cease to be incorporated members of the said Society.

## VI.

That there shall be a Standing Committee (three of whom shall be a quorum) to prepare the business for the meetings of the Society.

That the President, Vice-Presidents, and Secretary be *ex-officio* members of the Standing Committee.

That the other members of the Standing Committee, not exceeding twenty in number, being ten Clergymen, and ten Laymen, shall be elected by the Society, out of its incorporated members, at the Annual Meeting in June.

## VII.

That this Society shall at their annual meeting in each year, choose one or more Vice-Presidents, in addition to the Dignitaries ; one or more Treasurers ; two or more Auditors ; one Secretary : and such other officers as shall be thought necessary, provided that none but members of the Society be eligible to any office.

## VIII.

That the paid officers of the Society shall be the Secretary, and an Assistant if required, and that the former shall furnish security to the satisfaction of the President and Standing Committee.

## IX.

That if any vacancy occur by the death, removal, or resignation of any officer, the President shall appoint a successor until the next meeting of the Society.

## X.

That the Society shall meet in London, on the second Thursday in the months of March, June, September and December, and the Annual Meeting shall be held during the week in which the Synod meets ; and that the President or Standing Committee have power to call a special meeting of the Society at any time.

## XI.

That no act done in any meeting of the Society shall be valid and effectual, unless the President or some one of the Vice-Presidents shall be present at such meeting.

## XII.

That with regard to all meetings of the Society, and to the making, altering, or repealing any by-laws, rules or regulations, it is to be specially noticed that by the act of the Legislature, 7 Vic., ch. 68, it is enacted that no act of the Society, or meeting of the Corporation, shall be valid unless six persons of the Corporation, at the least, shall be present, and the major part of them consenting thereto. And, further, that no constitution, by-law,

rule, or regulation of the Society; nor any abrogation, repeal, change, or alteration of the same, shall be of any force or effect until it shall have been confirmed by the Bishop, in writing, under his hand.

## XIII.

That minutes of all the proceedings of the Society be taken, and that at each meeting of the Society the minutes of the preceding meeting be read by the Secretary, and signed by the Chairman.

## XIV.

That the accounts of the Society be closed on the 31st day of May, in each year, and that the same be audited within one month from that date.

## XV.

That the Secretary conduct the correspondence of the Society, take minutes of the proceedings of the general meetings and committees, prepare the annual report of the Society, attend meetings of the associations throughout the Diocese under the direction of the President, and take the superintendence of the affairs and the accounts of the Society in all its departments.

## XVI.

That in order more fully to promote the objects of the Society, each congregation, in the person of its clergyman and church-wardens, shall be a sub-association in correspondence, through its chairman, the clergyman, with the Parent Society, and may be denominated "*The Parochial Association of the Church Society.*" The Committee, which shall consist of the above named, with power to add to their number, shall meet so often and at such periods as they themselves decide to be most convenient, inviting the co-operation of all the parishioners in their deliberations and designs. They shall collect subscriptions and donations from the members of the Church, in such manner as they shall deem most effective, and endeavour, by every means in their power, to augment the resources of the Society. All moneys raised to be transmitted to the Secretary of the Parent Society.

## XVII.

That four collections be made annually, the proceeds of one of which shall be devoted to the Widow and Orphan's Fund, and that of the other three to Missionary purposes; and at such other times and for such purposes as the Bishop may direct. The collections to be forwarded to the Secretary of the Society. It shall be the duty of every clergyman to give notice of these collections, and to call the attention of their congregations to the importance of the objects, and their claims for liberal support.

## XVIII.

That all moneys shall be paid by cheques on the Treasurer, signed by the President and counter-signed by the Secretary.

## RESOLUTIONS

PASSED AT THE SECOND ANNUAL MEETING, HELD ON THE  
21ST JUNE, 1860.

---

The Annual Meeting of the Church Society was held in the City Hall, London, on Thursday evening, June 21st, 1860. The chair was taken by the President, the Right Rev. the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, at 7 o'clock, p. m. The Bishop read the appointed prayers. The Secretary read the report.

Moved by the Hon. G. J. Goodhue, seconded by Rev. J. Carmichael,—

1. That the Report now read be adopted, and that it be printed for distribution among the members of the Society and throughout the Diocese, and that the Revs. C. C. Brough, A.M., and R. Flood, A.M., the Hon. G. J. Goodhue, Lawrence Lawrason, A.Shade, Esqs., and Admiral Vidal be Vice Presidents; T. H. Buckley, and A. G. Smith, Esqs., be Auditors; the Gore Bank, Treasurer, V. Cronyn, Esq., B.C.L. be the Solicitor, and Rev. J. Walker Marsh, M.A., Secretary for the ensuing year.

Moved by L. Lawrason, Esq., seconded by Rev. E. Sullivan, A. B.,—

2. That the success of the Society during the past year, which has been one of great depression throughout the country, calls for especial thankfulness to Almighty God; while at the same time the returning prosperity points to the duty of greater exertions being made on behalf of the objects of the Society.

Moved by Rev F. W. Sandys, D. D., seconded by Rev. J. Vicars,—

3. That this Society feels a deep interest in the success of Gospel Truth throughout the world, and the visible manifestations of the Divine blessing so plainly seen of late both in Europe and on our continent.

Moved by H. C. R. Becher, Esq., Q. C., seconded by Rev. A. Palmer, M.A.,—

4. That, while rejoicing in the continued prosperity of the great Church Societies in the mother country, and of similar institutions in our sister colonies, we must not forget that the great spiritual destitution which still prevails in the Diocese demands our first attention, and requires every Churchman to exert himself to the utmost of his ability to support the Church Society, which is the chief means, under God, of relieving this destitution.

## SECOND ANNUAL REPORT

OF

### *The Incorporated Church Society*

OF THE

### DIOCESE OF HURON,

PRESENTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING AT LONDON, HELD ON  
THURSDAY, JUNE 21ST, 1860.

---

In bringing their Second Annual Report before the Society, the committee feel that they are called upon in the first place to acknowledge the bounteous hand of our heavenly Father, who has so eminently blessed the "small things" with which the Church Society of the Diocese of Huron had to commence its career; for already the committee may congratulate the Society that the day of small things is passing away, and the income of the Society beginning to swell into proportions somewhat more commensurate with the important work which the Society has to fulfil.

Last year the income of the Society was \$3,540.88, which was the result of much exertion, and of all the freshness of zeal and liberality which was naturally displayed in the circumstances under which our Society was established, this year the more creditable sum of \$6,387.68 is obtained; being an increase over last year of no less than \$2,846.75, wanting only \$694.13 of doubling last year's income; and this, it should be borne in mind, has been attained during a year of almost unprecedented commercial depression, and one marked by disappointments to the farmer hardly ever experienced in former years.

Still, however, notwithstanding these gratifying results, much remains yet to be done, and there is room for further improvement during the coming year; the increased returns made to the Society have been obtained by an extended sphere of operation; many parts of the Diocese have this year contributed to the Church Society which were never reached before, and there remain many places which have yet to connect themselves with the Church Society.

And here, before noticing the different funds of the Society, your committee would desire briefly to notice two cases as samples to show the exertions which have been made for the Society during the past year. First they will take London, which stands, as indeed it should do, at the head of the list: from the congregation of St. Paul's Cathedral and from the Parochial Association connected therewith, and from the life and incorporated members who have subscribed to the same, no less a sum than \$1009.38 has been poured into the treasury of the Church Society, a sum very nearly equal to  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the whole income of the Society last year, and this is exclusive of large sums raised for local purposes, and to aid in foreign objects, amounting to \$5300.64 as per list in appendix. As a second instance of increased liberality they will take the congregation of Bayfield, on the shores of lake Huron, a small, and, in point of wealth, a poor congregation; last year the whole sum sent by this congregation was \$1.12, this year from collections and Parochial Association the liberal sum of \$58.33 has been contributed, besides \$5.00 sent by the venerable incumbent, who has ministered there for years, and whose ill health caused the omission of three of the collections for the Society during the past year, otherwise the sum would have been greatly increased.

Looking at these cases your committee believe they are justified in calling upon the members of the Society to "thank God and take courage," for they believe that He who has thus prospered us in our past labors will continue to vouchsafe His blessing, if only we are found faithful to Him and labor with a single eye to his glory.

The income of the past year is made up as follows.

From Life and Incorporated Members' subscriptions.....	\$ 887.00

This is the amount of Income proper, but considerably more than twice that sum has passed through the accounts of the Society during the last year, as may be seen by the balance sheet in the appendix.

#### WIDOWS AND ORPHANS' FUND.

Besides the Annual Collection made during the month of January and other donations, \$775.00 has been carried to the credit of this fund for Incorporated Members' subscriptions paid during the year, as per regulation of the Society, from which, when the expenditure for investments already made in the Building Society, &c., is deducted, there yet remains to the credit of this fund a balance of \$839.58, most of which may be immediately invested.

#### MISSION FUND.

The total amount received from this fund during the past year in collections and donations has been \$2,100.66, added to which \$120.00 has been repaid for advanced to missionaries during the previous year. No regular system of salaries from this fund has yet been adopted by the Society, but the Bishop, under the sanction of the Society's regulation, has made grants from this fund to various missionaries and students during the past year, amounting to \$1217, besides a special grant voted to Rev. J. Carey of \$100, and \$375 paid to Indian interpreters and school masters. This fund has been largely increased by the custom of making collections at the Church Society meetings throughout the Diocese, which is now followed almost everywhere, and your committee would urge its adoption in all cases; from this source alone nearly \$600 have been received, which is more than equal to an extra collection for this fund. There is a balance of \$1,521.31 to the credit of this fund.

#### DEPOSITORY FUND.

This is a new fund which was commenced by collections being made on the day appointed in the month of November last as a day of thanksgiving to Almighty God for mercies received; the response to this call, including donations, was \$387.13, which has been expended in the purchase of prayer books and hymn books, a large quantity of which are on hand to supply the wants of the Diocese.



## PAROCHIAL ASSOCIATIONS.

The meetings for the Society have been held in almost every congregation in this Diocese during the past year, and liberal contributions have been sent from almost all the Parochial Associations; and the interest excited in the Society's work throughout the Diocese by the visits of the deputations sent out makes it desirable to continue this plan in future years.

The sum received on this account this year was \$2,284.60, which with the balance on hand last year has been carried to General Purposes fund, making a balance at present to the credit of that fund of \$1865.42, out of which the expenses of the Society must be taken, and then the balance can be carried to the credit of the Mission Fund, which is the chief branch of the Society's operations.

## EPISCOPAL FUND.

This Fund is in the hands of a Committee to arrange and report upon; a full statement of this Fund will be given in the Appendix. Since the 1st of January last \$100 has been received by the Secretary towards the capital of this Fund, which has been invested in the usual way, and \$358.60 of interest, which has been paid towards the Episcopal Income.

---

During the past year the division of the funds and property of the late Diocese of Toronto has been completed, according to the award agreed to by the two Bishops and the late S. J. B. Macauley. A statement of the funds received will be found in the Appendix.

## COMMUTATION FUND.

The amount received from Toronto on behalf of this Fund was \$261,409.00 in debentures, and \$4,795.00 in cash. This has been re-invested, by which a large addition has been made to the capital of this Fund, and, as several thousand dollars of debentures mature during the coming year, this Fund will be greatly increased before the next annual statement is made. The annual interest accruing from this Fund is now more than sufficient to meet the salaries at present chargeable on it, but, owing to the salaries becoming due in advance of the periods at which much

of the interest is payable, a large sum will have to be borrowed quarterly for short periods from the Bank, on which interest will have to be paid. This has been done for the quarter ending April 1st, as the accounts will show.

Such is a brief view of the chief funds of the Society ; the full details of all the accounts will be found in the Appendix.

Your Committee cannot conclude this Report without acknowledging the valuable assistance which is given to this Diocese by the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel in Foreign Parts, the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and the Colonial Church & School Society, as well as by the many friends beyond the bounds of the Diocese and in the mother country, who have taken a deep interest in the work of the Diocese, and in many cases contributed liberally to assist the Bishop in the arduous and important work of supplying the destitution which still prevails in the Diocese. Among these friends your Committee would desire to take special notice of the liberal donation of the Lord Bishop of Cashel, who has promised the Bishop £100 sterling towards supplying a mission in the County of Grey with a clergyman ; nor would they omit to record the munificent donations of two young men in Toronto, barristers on the threshold of the profession, to one of whom we are indebted this year for \$100 and to the other for \$50. Your Committee notice these examples of liberality in the hope that others may be induced to do likewise.

To the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel in Foreign Parts this Diocese has been indebted from the beginning for assistance, towards the support of missionaries in the northern counties, and your Committee learn, with the liveliest emotions of gratitude, that an additional grant has lately been made by this Society for missionary work in the Diocese.

To the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge the Diocese has been largely indebted for assistance towards building churches, and, seeing that large portions of this Diocese are entirely without churches, and that others are wanted in all parts of the Diocese, your Committee would fain hope that this Venerable Society will be induced to continue this assistance for many years to come.

To the Colonial Church and School Society, also, this Diocese is largely indebted for assistance, towards the support of missionaries in various parts, and many additions have been made to the clergy by the liberality of this

Society, and thus parts of the Diocese have been supplied with the ministrations of religion which, had it not been for their assistance, must have remained destitute up to this time.

In conclusion, your Committee would desire to remind the members of the Society that their work is only just commenced, and earnestly to point out the duty of all to assist in this great work to the utmost of their ability, and when they look around at the many blessings which we are all continually receiving at the hands of our Heavenly Father, and hear of the liberal assistance given by others beyond the bounds of the Diocese, surely they may say in the words of the Lord himself to those who are enjoying all these blessings, "Freely ye have received, freely give."

All which is respectfully submitted.
