Survey responses Feb 15, 2017



Background

A survey was created to recruit participants for upcoming user studies (eg. iOS Diary study and persona interviews for Android and iOS). A recruiting message with a link to the survey was shown in an announcement card at the top of the Explore feed on Android and iOS from February 9-13.

Along with gathering a list of potential participants, we were also able to collect information related to app usage, motivation and demographic information.

Demographic information

- 3438 survey respondents Android (48.9%), iOS (49.4%)
- 52 different countries US (71.3%), UK (13.8%), CA (7.1%)
- The majority of respondents were between the ages of 26 and 59

40-59 (34.6%), 26-39 (31.9%), 60-75 (13.9%), 18-25 (13%), under 18 (4.8%), 75 or older (1.4%)


- Around 350 respondents read Wikipedia in multiple languages Around 10% of responses


• Less than half of respondents have edited or contributed to Wikipedia

Never edited (60.9%), Once or twice (32.2), Regularly (6.9%)


When did you download the Wikipedia app?
