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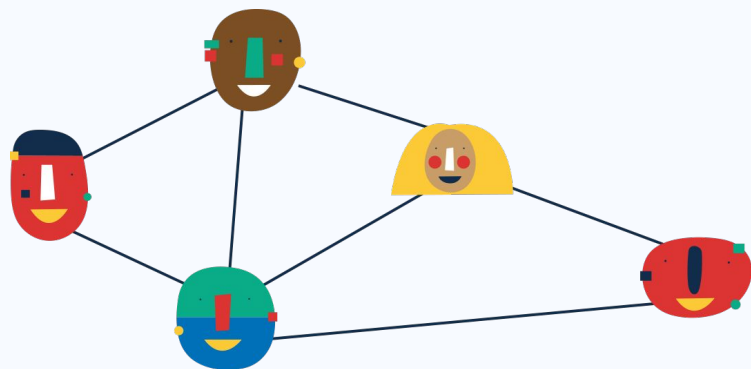

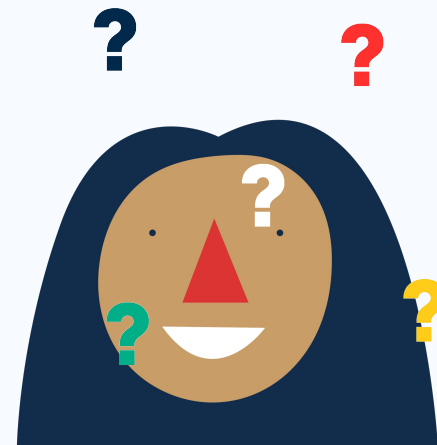
Let's Connect

Community led- Foundation supported



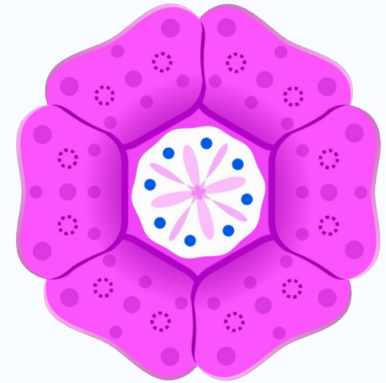
Collaborative program with Community and Foundation that enables:

- Community Working Group guide and create the sense of joint-ownership with the community.
- Foundation providing the platform and support to highlight community work, learnings and networking?



Why peer learning?

- Horizontal, non-formal and flexible ways of sharing knowledge amongst colleagues.
- Builds social connections and cooperation.
- Diverse formats for a continuous, autonomous process, driven by needs and interests as they arise.
- **Complements**, not replaces, other forms of more formal training and other capacity building initiatives.

Average per learning clinic is 30 people.

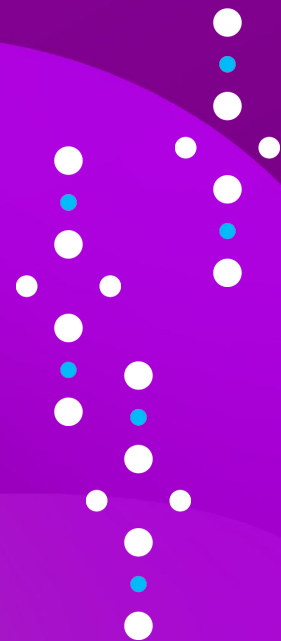

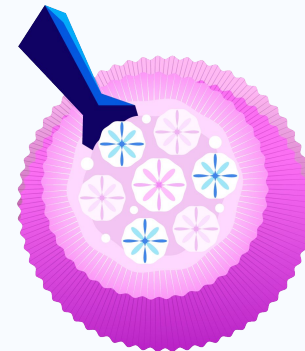
What Learning Clinics do you have in mind?

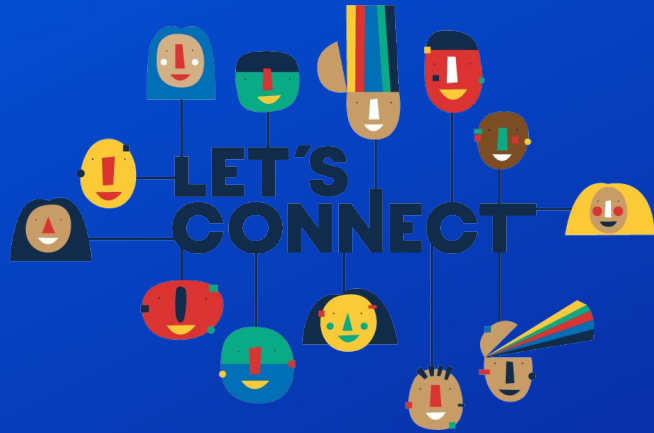
