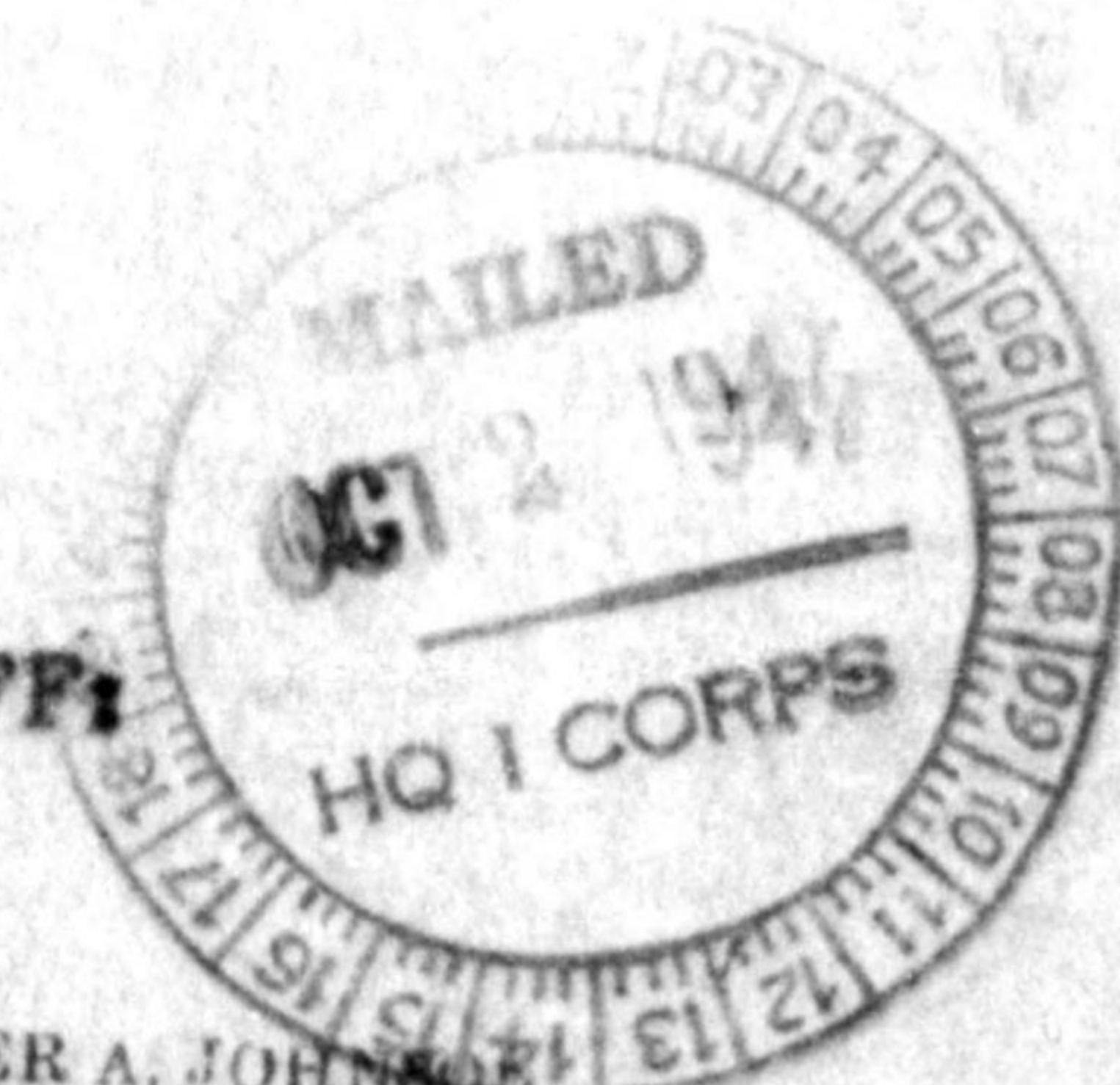

SUBJECT: Import of Crude Rubber and Latex - Singapore to  
 Yokohama/Kobe

1. Pursuant to paragraph 6 of Memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG 334 (3 Apr 46) ESS/IF, (SCAPIN 854), dated 3 April 1946, subject: Board of Trade (Boeki Cho), Boeki Cho is directed to take delivery or cause delivery to be taken in its name and for its account of approximately 59 long tons of latex and approximately 300 long tons of crude rubber from on board the SS Foochow, estimated date of arrival 18 September 1947 at the port of Yokohama, and approximately 130 long tons of crude rubber estimated date of arrival 21 September 1947 at the port of Kobe.
2. Quantitative receipts in quintuplicate (5 copies) showing the total quantity of crude rubber and latex manifested and received from the above vessel will be signed and sealed by the officially designated agency of Boeki Cho in the proper space provided in the receipt. A survey report of quality will be prepared in quintuplicate (5 copies) by a competent agency appointed by Boeki Cho. This survey report will contain a complete qualitative description of the crude rubber and latex quantities and grades received and stating any additional information relating to the quality description of the cargo.
3. These receipts will be submitted for each shipment to the Commanding Officer, Local Military Government Unit, at port of discharge.
4. Boeki Cho will transfer by sale to such agency, agencies or individuals as may be designated by the appropriate Bureau of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the crude rubber latex imported in accordance with these instructions.
5. A monthly report of the allocations and consumption of imported crude rubber and latex will be made to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers on the fifteenth day of each month. This report will contain information as to quantities by grades allocated, stating the rubber products manufactured.
6. These instructions shall be in effect with respect to all deliveries of crude rubber and latex taken by Boeki Cho until further notice.
