

1. The Secretary of the Security Advisory Board has now completed a check of the FBI subversive files on all Security Officers listed on SAB 4/1, dated 4 October 1946. It will be recalled that records were previously found on five Security Officers of which only one was considered sufficiently derogatory to justify the removal of the name from the list of Security Officers.

2. In the final group of names submitted for security checks, derogatory information has been discovered on a Security Officer of a Government Department. If the Board determines, on the basis of this information, that there is sufficient reason to justify removal of the name from the list, it will be necessary to determine a definite course of action to be followed by the Board. This matter was not resolved at the 7th Meeting of the Board on October 29, 1946, at which a similar incident was discussed, in view of the fact that the agency in question was determined to be a quasi-official one which the Board could not service under its terms of reference.

3. It is requested that the Board members give some consideration to the course of action which it will follow in the event it determines the information on the Security Officer in question is sufficiently derogatory to justify his removal from the list.

E X T R A C TCONFIDENTIALCONFIDENTIALITEM IV. Serial No. 78, (8 October 1946). SECURITY CHECKS.

MRS. BARTON read from a report received regarding the Security Officer of the American National Red Cross. COMDR. DALY asked if there were anything which the Board could do, now that this information was in its possession. COL. BLAKENEY said that the War and Navy Departments could prevent the agency from receiving any more classified military information. COMDR. DALY agreed that this could be done but stated that the Board was placed in a very awkward position by having the subject's name on an SAB memorandum which had supposedly received the blessing of the Board before being issued. MRS. BARTON asked if the agency received much classified information from the War and Navy Departments. COL. BLAKENEY felt that they did not receive much information from the War Department of a classified nature now that the war was over, and COMDR. DALY said that the Navy's situation in this respect was similar.

MR. ANDERSON asked if the investigative agencies were planning to take any action in this instance. MRS. BARTON replied that there had been no investigation made to date and that she did not know what action they planned to take.

COMDR. DALY asked if the Board regarded the Red Cross as a federal agency. MRS. BARTON said that it had always been treated as such and added that she believed that the Red Cross Headquarters here was composed of Civil Service employees. COMDR. DALY said that he did not believe the

agency had any Civil Service employees and that the Red Cross should be treated as a non-federal agency. MRS. BARTON promised to investigate the exact status of Red Cross employees.

MR. ANDERSON suggested that the Secretary talk with the investigative agencies to determine:

- (1) What action was taken when an investigation was completed and the interests of security demanded that the individual be removed from government office?
- (2) What was the position of the agencies regarding revelation of the information when the investigation was completed and information was conclusive?
- (3) Would there be any objection to the Board's revealing at least the general outline of the derogatory information to the head of an agency when the subject on whom the investigation was made was the Security Officer?
- (4) Would any of the investigative agencies send a representative to a <sup>off-the-record</sup> Board meeting for discussion of the personnel security question? If not, would a representative meet with the Chairman and the Secretary?

Upon determination of the answers to these questions, MR. ANDERSON suggested that the Secretary discuss them with COL. BLAKENEY who would then take whatever action the War Department desired in this connection.

MRS. BARTON then read brief reports on Security Officers from the Securities and Exchange Commission, Tennessee Valley Authority, National Housing Agency, and Federal Security

Agency, and the Board agreed that the information was not sufficiently negative in nature to warrant any action being taken by the Board.

MRS. BARTON stated that she had received derogatory information on six of the people listed by OWM and R to receive classified information, and after hearing the information, the Board agreed that recommendations should be made to the Security Officer of that agency that all but one of these six people be denied access to classified information.

COMDR. DALY asked if there was any danger in revelation of source through making these recommendations. MRS. BARTON stated that she believed the Security Officer of OWM&R understood that all sources would be checked and that she would try to make that clear in the reply to his letter. MR. ANDERSON asked that the Board clear this letter before it was sent and suggested further that it might be cleared with SWNCC and the investigative agencies. COMDR. DALY suggested that MRS. BARTON determine definitely if the investigative agencies had any objection to such recommendations being made at this time.

COMDR. DALY said that the entire question of personnel security in government agencies and departments was one which justified a thorough exploration and a possible submission to SWNCC for decision as to who should make the final determinations. The Board agreed that there should be further discussion of this matter at a later date.

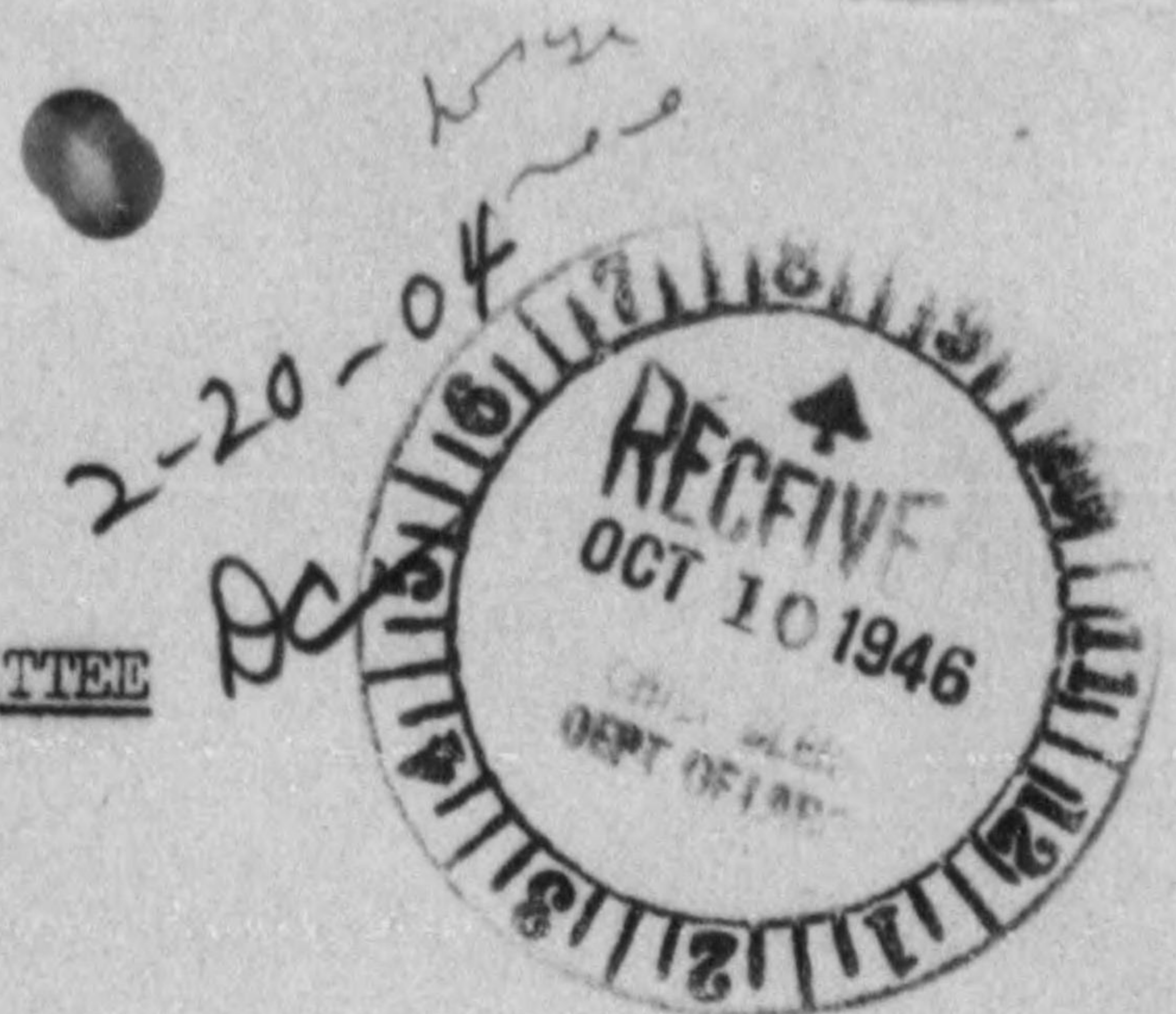

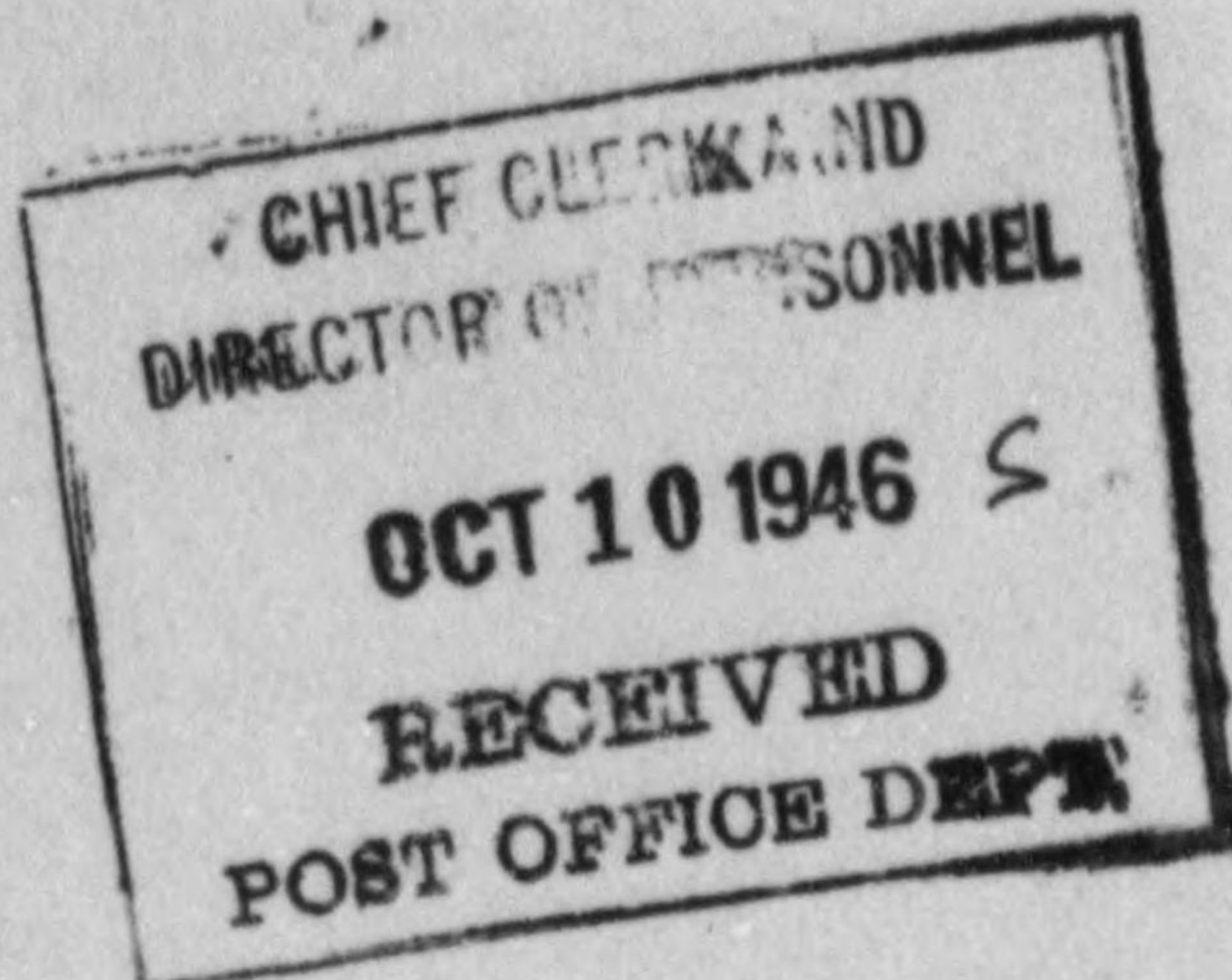
