The Middlesex Surveyors report that the engine & boiler spaces have been efficiently cleared, the drainage pipes fitted to the inside, the water-tight doors fitted to the tunnel top the watertight bulkhead & the windlass & other steering gear examined as recommended by the British Marine Surveyor.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed +100A1 (2nd) "Spar deck with freeboard," as recommended. The Summer freeboard of 3' 0" from centre of disc to top of statutory deck line at spar deck, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate, and recorded in the Register Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying verification form to be inserted in the certificate of classification.
