#### 4. Business outline of Live-stocks Health Guidance Office.

The office is established for the purpose of increasing of live-stocks and preventing of epidemics, and it takes the following measures for the achievement of the above purposes:

- 1) Maintenance of live-stock health:
  - a. Practical guidance to the health and nourishment.
  - b. Guidance to improvement of stall and play-ground, and to raising administration in grazings.
  - c. Guidance to healthy fodder and circumstances.
- 2) Elevation of breeding of live-stocks:
  - a. Inspection and good treatment for disease of the reproductive organs.
  - b. Observation of animals sexual excitement and instructing in siring.
  - c. Application of artificial insemination.
  - d. Judgement of conception.
  - e. Inspection of semen.
- 3) Preventives for animals' epidemics:
  - a. Clinical treatment of infectious epidemic and proper measures for disease condition.
  - b. Issuance of certificates in accordance with Article 25-2, Live-stocks Infectious Epidemic Preventive Law.
  - c. Isolation of diseased animal and disinfection method when epidemic occurs.
  - d. Execution of inoculation.

Notes: General clinical treatment for diseased animals is, as a rule, not conducted except a case of village without veterinary surgeons.

Facilities and medical tools equipped in the office is opened to free use of private veterinary surgeons and other organization's technicians.
