Doc. # 548-Q CHAPTER AVIT Transitional Security Artangements Article 10 Pending the coming into force of such modical agreements referred to in Articl: 43 as in the opinion of the Security Council enable it to begin the exercise of its responsibilities under Article 42, the parties to the Four-Nation Declaration, signed at Moscow, Actober 30, 1943, and France, shall, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 5 of that Doclaration, consult with one another and as occasion requires with other Members of the United Nations with a view to such joint action on behalf of the Organization as may be necessary for the purpose of maintaining international peace and security. Article 107 Nothing in the present Charter shall invilidate or preclude action, in relation to any state which during the Second World War has been an enemy of any signatory to the present Charter, taken or authorized as a result of that war by the Governments having responsibility for such action.
