Article 1. In accordance with the provisions of Article 10 of the Local Finance Law (Law No. 109 of 1948), the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry shall, under these Regulations, pay to the Metropolis, Hokkaido and Prefectures the National Government allotment for the expenses necessary for the repairs of fishing ports damaged by storms, floods, earthquakes and other disasters.

- 3. Regulations concerning payment of expenses to be borne by the Metropolis, Hokkaido or Prefectural Government to the cities, towns, villages and other associations designated by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry (hereinafter to be referred to as "city, town, village and others ")
- Article 4. In case the Governor of the Metropolis, Hokkaido or prefecture intends to make any vital alteration in the particulars of the documents mentioned in the preceding Article, he shall give a previous notice to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry thereof;
- 2 In case the notice as mentioned in the preceding paragraph has been given, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may, when deemed necessary, direct to make any alteration relative to the matters notified.
- Article 5. The forms of the results of enterprise and the statement of settled accounts to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 of the Regulations shall be as specified in the attached forms No. 3 and No. 2.
- 2 The Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may, when deemed necessary, request presentation of any other documents in addition to the results of enterprise and the statement of settled accounts.
- Article 6. In case the Governor of the Metropolis, Hokkaido or prefecture has made the city, town, village and others return the Government allotment which had been paid to them before, he shall report to that effect to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry without delay, stating the reasons therefor.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Regulations shall apply as from April 1, 1949.
