Prior to the war Matsushita manfactured ordinary electrial appliances such as flat irons, radio, lamps, etc. They did not become engaged in war work ": until the end of 42, and then only to a small degree. Their first large scale conversation to wartime manufacture took place in 1943: Matsushita was also engaged in the manfacture of wooden ships, bombs, etc.
