

MEXICO– Tropical Cyclone COSME

- COSME is moving over open waters in the Pacific, ca. 600km WSW of Mexico. At 09:00 UTC 25 June it was a Tropical Storm, expected to become a Hurricane later in the day.
- Although moving away from Mexico and far from the coast, moderate to heavy rains by COSME might still affect the coasts of SW Mexico and Socorro island ([GDACS](#), [NOAA](#), [Mexican Meteo](#))





Malaysia & Singapore – Atmospheric Pollution

- Fires burning in Sumatra (Indonesia) for several days have caused record levels of air pollution in Singapore and Malaysia.
- Due to the haze, all schools in southern Malaysia remained closed on 24 June and outdoor activities were suspended.
- In Singapore, haze has receded since 21 June, when it reached potentially “life-threatening” levels. ([Malaysian News Agency](#), ECHO, [BNPB](#), [Media](#))

South Sudan – Refugees & Security

- Hepatitis, since Sep 2012: Maban ref. camp, Upper Nile: 10,569 cases, 191 deaths. Yida ref. camp, Unity state: 435 cases, 13 deaths. Doro camp, Upper Nile: 429 cases, 19 deaths.
- Relocation of 18,000 refugees from flood-prone Jamam camp to new site in Kaya completed.
- \$485 million funding shortfall identified.
- Security: An international NGO staff member killed near Yei in Central Equatorial State, while on a duty road trip (ECHO)
