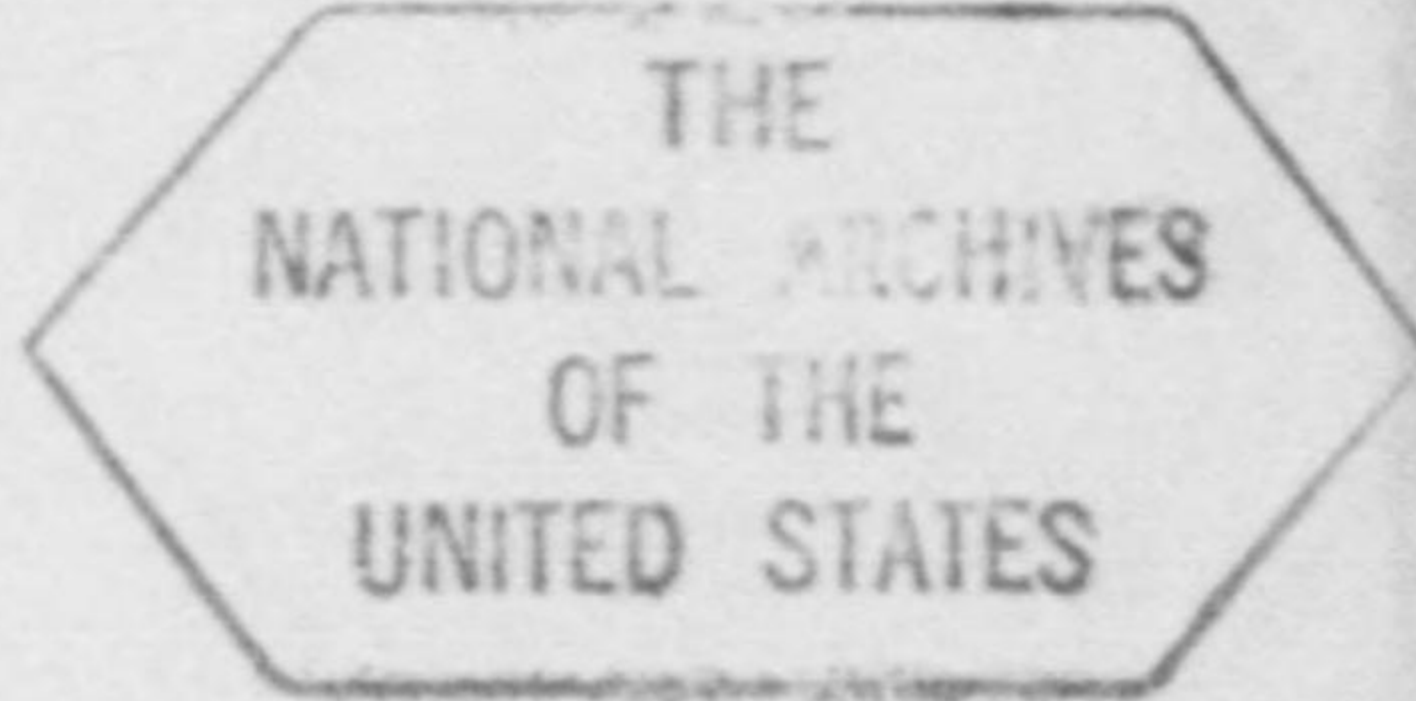

Headquarters Kanto Civil Affairs Region, APO 500

TO: Chief, Civil Affairs Section, GHQ, SCAP, APO 500

1. In accordance with paragraph 2 of basis, following are comments and recommendations relative to use of real estate described in attached correspondence for JNPR units:

a. Former Numama Workers' Dormitory, Yokosuka Naval Construction Department: Area is of no use to the JNPR. Area is being rented as dwellings and only four of the original six buildings are intact. Recommend release.

b. Former Senjojikiyama Navy Defense Fortress: All original structures have been removed except the foundations. Area is on top of a hill with a flat area of 50 by 200 yards. Area is presently in use by an Occupation Forces Padar Unit, consisting of 11 enlisted men, tents and equipment. Area is of no use to the JNPR. Recommend release as flat area could be used for farming.

c. Former Sakado Barracks, Headquarters Army Air Corps: All former buildings have been destroyed and the area is presently used for farming. Recommend release.

d. Former Ninomiya Salt Making Plant, Fishing Team of Sagami First Naval Air Force: Area is presently being used as a fish fertilizer plant. Area is of no possible use for the JNPR. Recommend release.

2. Inspections of the above listed areas were made by Major Louis M Szymaszek and Department of the Army Civilian Phillip J Sprow, this headquarters, and were checked for possible training areas in addition to housing and storage use. Areas are generally inaccessible for vehicles and are widely scattered. Recommend all sites be released to the Japanese Government.
