<u>Emphasized subject</u>	<u>Development of activities</u>
1. Mugi sowing guidance	Mugi sowing was retarded, failing to get timely period for seeding due to bad weather. The following points were stressed for counter-measure. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Selection of suitable species for retarded sowing.</li> <li>2. Complete publicity on prevention against possible damages caused by dampness and also guidance for sowing in uneven lands.</li> <li>3. Improvement of manner of seeding.</li> <li>4. Budding guidance.</li> </ol>
2. Dissemination of book keeping in farm household.	Since the fundamental survey is essential for betterment of farm management, efforts were taken to make farmers keep books completely starting from January next year.
3. Taking care of domestic animals during winter	Guidance was given for pertinent care to be taken in bringing up domestic animals specifically during severely cold weather.

C. Exterminate lice to prevent eruptive typhus.

When winter comes, eruptive typhus will prevail again. Let us prevent the growth of lice, which will spread the germs of eruptive typhus.

- a. Take a bath often and keep your hair and body clean.
- b. Keep your clothings and beddings clean.
- c. If your clothes become verminous, vermines should be killed by ironing or pouring hot water. Then sprinkle DDT on the clothes.
- d. DDT sprinkled clothes should be left as they are. You must not try to shake off DDT.
- e. Kill lice, putting them into fire instead of squashing them with fingers.

D. Our "Nutrition Week" (21 - 27 October)

If you continue washing down cleaned-rice with tea, you will suffer from want of nutrition. You need not spend much money to take nutritious food. Rationed rice, barley or bread with well proportioned amount of vegetables and meat or fish will do. In autumn we have good appetite. Let us try to take substantially nutritious food.

E. Why do spiages not grow well?

If any crop does not grow well due to unknown cause, the peculiarity that has occurred in the soil may account for it. In such cases, consult with the farmland extension agent immediately. They will examine the soil by machinery and will tell you what to do.



- F. Demonstrative exhibition of the "garden tractor".  
The agricultural mechanization is a new problem of the Japanese agriculture. Of late many machines have been invented and the demonstrative exhibition of the cultivating machines manufactured at various places of the country will be held as follows:

3. Condition of crops

The weather in both beginning and middle of this month was of high temperature, full of sunshine with little rain.

The growth of paddy rice was generally progressing smoothly and all kinds of paddy rice had rather high halm. As to the time of growing the ear, early rice was of normal and late rice was late two to four days as compared with the ordinary year.

In general there was an outbreak of *hypochnus sasakii* and the rice was prostrated. Moreover, outbreak of *bacterium oryzae* and *piricularia oryzae* also can be seen in various places.

The rice crop may be said rather good as stated above.

The upland rice, owing to high temperature, full of sunshine with little rain, sustained dry damage. However, rain fall in the middle of September restored them and the crop showed good progress.

As to the outbreak of disease and harmful insects, there can be seen *parnora guttatus* and *cochibolus Miyabeanus* in some place.

The condition of sweet potato and cereals crop is of the average year.
