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## PREFACE.

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The pedagogical section of the University of California Library is only in its beginnings. A number of additions have been made since this list was completed. Many gaps will still be apparent, which it is the intention of the University authorities to fill as soon as possible. The need of a catalogue such as this, to put into the hands of students, has become so evident that it has been deemed best to prepare it at once without waiting to supply even the most obvious deficiencies.

The preparation of this catalogue was begun by Miss Inez L. Robinson, of the class of '93, in connection with the work of the undergraduate seminary in Pedagogy. The major part of the work has been done by Miss Katherine M. Wertz, fellow in Pedagogy for the year 1893-4.

In the classification of books, valuable suggestions have been received from Dr. Hall's Bibliography of Educational Literature, and the catalogue of the Pedagogical Library in the office of the Superintendent of Schools, Philadelphia. In some cases the classification has been adjusted to the convenience of classes in the University, and in some other cases to the general plan of the Library.

This catalogue includes only those books that are to be found in alcoves LL and MM of the Library. There are many works in other alcoves that have a more or less direct bearing on important educational questions. A catalogue of such works as these may be attempted at another time.

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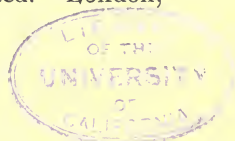
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
