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

PREFACE.


Although Mr. O. H. Berg, the owner of this collection, has been widely known for many years as an ardent student of numismatics, still but few persons were aware of the success which attended his labors; unostentatious in his demeanor, he naturally always disliked to make a parade of his possessions; having ample means at his command, and being an enthusiastic and persistent worker, he had gathered up in a quiet way many treasures which will prove a genuine surprise to his friends.

Mr. Berg, not unlike the most of coin collectors, first endeavored to complete a scries of the regular issues of the United States Mint—beginning with the copper coinage, then silver dollars, etc. At this incipient stage of his pursuit he fortunately secured many fine specimens; after obtaining the 1804 dollar, he soon lost his interest in these departments and early abandoned the accumulation of dates, and sought for types or specimens of a more representative character, such as foreign crowns and medals, also a general assortment of Colonial coins of America, Washington pieces, national and political medals, foreign coins, medals and tokens in silver and copper, etc. A perusal of the catalogue will show that Mr. Berg collected and preserved many fine, rare, and beautiful examples.
