



- **Severe drought conditions** continue to affect **Somalia, South-East Ethiopia** and **North-East Kenya**.
- **Over 15 million people** in the region are facing **food security crisis** and food insecurity has increased in all three countries over the last 6 months
- Without continued humanitarian support this situation is likely to **deteriorate in early 2018**

Number of people in urgent need of food assistance:

- **8.3 million** in **Ethiopia**
- **3.3 million** in **Somalia**
- **3 million** in **Kenya**

EU Commission Response

Ethiopia

- **2017** €91.5 million (approx. 60% drought)
- Initial allocation for 2018 is €26 million (not yet allocated among the various crises).

Somalia

- **2017** €118.75 million for the drought.
- Initial allocation for 2018 is €39 million (100% drought).

Kenya

- **2017** €23.8 million (45% drought).
- Initial allocation for 2018 is €10 million (25% drought).

Acute Food Insecurity Phase IPC's projection Dec. 2017 – Jan. 2018

- IPC 1 - Minimal
- IPC 2 - Stressed
- IPC 3 - Crisis
- IPC 4 - Emergency
- IPC 5 - Famine
