SUBJECT: Retention in assignment as Civil Information Officer,
Kyushu Civil Affairs Region

TO : Commanding General, 8th Army, APO 343
ATTN: Civil Affairs Section

1. In connection with the contemplated re-organization of Civil Affairs, it is desired to set forth the following facts pertaining to the status and qualifications of the undersigned and request that in view of same consideration be given to retention in my present assignment.

2. On the basis of possessing special qualifications the undersigned was recalled to Active Duty on 15 August 1948 by the Dept. of the Army for duty in the subject assignment. Previous service of approximately six (6) months in the same position had been rendered both in a military and civilian status. In addition the undersigned had served as Area Provost Court Officer for fifteen (15) months previously, making a total service on Kyushu of over thirty (30) months to date. The Dept. of the Army Orders recalling me to Active Duty specified service for an indefinite period as long as the position was in existence assuming my services were satisfactory. It is my understanding that the position of Civil Information Officer, Kyushu Civil Affairs Region will continue to be in existence under the above mentioned re-organization plan.

3. Among additional reasons why it is felt my retention in present assignment would be to the advantage of the Government are the following:

(a) The undersigned organized the Civil Information Section in this Region when it was separated from the former Civil Information and Education Section. Very extensive liaison contacts among Japanese officials in all prefectures in this region have been made as a result of frequent field trips to all parts of Kyushu by rail, water and jeep. In the past nine months the undersigned has visited and held conferences in every Gun District Office on Kyushu numbering 76 in all. The above familiarity with the Prefectural Governments, the contacts established with Prefectural Officials and knowledge of the informational media available in

this Region are very exceptional. To duplicate the above knowledge and contacts would take another person many months. This knowledge and contacts established will be especially valuable and necessary when one Regional Office will have to cover the entire area. In view of the above it is believed that the maximum efficiency of future operations would be obtained through my retention in present assignment.

(b) It is believed that, on the basis of economy, it would be to the best interests of the Government that I be retained in my present assignment. If the Dept. of the Army relieved me from Active Duty my Retired Pay as a Major would have to be paid out of current Dept. of the Army appropriations without any service being rendered to the Government while at the same time a Civilian would have to be paid a full time salary to fill my present position. The differential between my Retired and Active Pay which I am now receiving is far less than the salary of a full time Civilian in the classification of position I am now filling. The Civilian's Pay would also have to come out of current Dept. of the Army appropriations.

(c) In view of the predominate importance of Kyushu in connection with the economic rehabilitation of Japan based upon its large percentages in the national production of such vital commodities as coal, steel, and chemicals combined with the fact that the Kyushu Region is the largest Region in Japan, it is believed would warrant special consideration, if necessary, to retain as Civil Information Officer in this Region a person who has special qualifications for this position.

4. Based upon the general background information contained in this letter plus the special advantages to the Government as set forth in the preceding paragraph it is requested that provision be made for the retention of the undersigned as Civil Information Officer, Kyushu Civil Affairs Region.
